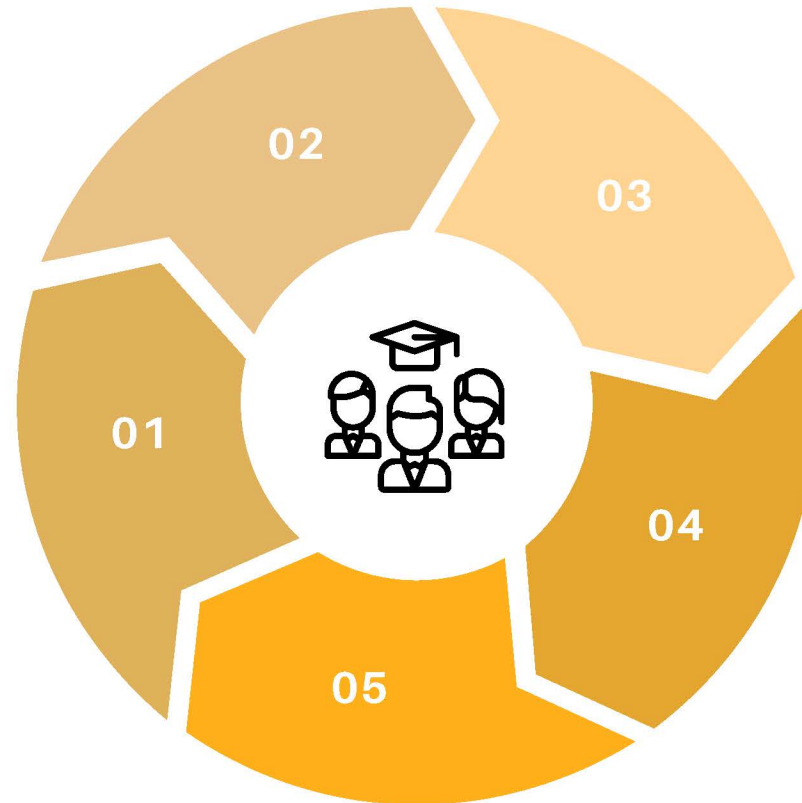

# Reentry Updates

- **Reentry Survey for Parents and Guardians**
  - Distributed July 24
  - 17,032 surveys sent
  - **80.4% response rate** as of 2:30 PM on August 5
    - 13,700 responses
  - **65.1%** of respondents have selected **in-person** instruction
    - 8,916 students
  - **32.4%** of respondents have selected **FIVE**
    - 4,437 students

# Reentry Updates

## Human Resources Formal Request for a Virtual Work Assignment

- Distributed July 29
- 2,576 surveys sent
- 620 Responses as of 4:55 PM on August 5
  - 64.1% of respondents have no preference.
    - 398 Responses
  - 13.9% of respondents prefer a virtual work option, but are able to work in person.
    - 86 Responses
  - 7.9% of respondents have documentation of a CDC high-risk concern and are only able to work virtually.
    - 49 Responses
  - 6.5% of respondents prefer a virtual option due to COVID-19 related childcare concerns.
    - 40 Responses
  - 3.9% of respondents do not have a virtual option based on their job, but will submit a request for accommodation.
    - 24 Responses
  - 3.7% of respondents have documentation of a CDC high-risk concern for a family member they are caring for and are only able to work virtually.
    - 23 Responses

# REENTRY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Your input is important to us. Surveys and questions help us identify and communicate the information our families need to make informed decisions. Since schools were closed in March, School District Five has fielded questions and received input regarding the start of the 2020-2021 school year. **How do the cohorts work?** School District Five will place students in one of two cohorts, or subgroups of students, under the hybrid schedule option. These cohorts are designed to divide and limit the number of (hybrid schedule) students on school campuses. For more information regarding cohorts including 4K, elementary and high school, visit [www.lexrich5.org/20-21reentry](http://www.lexrich5.org/20-21reentry).

**If my child is in the online option, when and how can s/he transition to in-person learning, vice versa?** We are asking that families of elementary school students commit to at least a quarter and that families of secondary students commit to at least a semester before requesting a change in their scheduling option. We also realize that there may be special circumstances. Therefore, families with documented medical concerns may request reassignment outside of the aforementioned times by following our district's "Hardship" procedures through our Office of Planning and Administration.

**Will childcare be provided to employees?** Childcare has been a popular topic for many working individuals and households nationwide, as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact daily lives. We've received questions regarding this from our own employees. Like all other matters brought to our attention regarding our reentry planning, the topic of employee childcare for school-aged children has been forwarded to our reentry committee for further discussion, research and consideration.

**Who will be provided a device?** All students 5K-12 will receive devices, whether they are FIVE students or students on a hybrid schedule. Since school plans were distributed last week, the district has been able to secure devices for 1st graders in our district in addition to having devices for 2nd-12th graders.

**Will virtual students be able to participate in onsite extra curricular activities?** Yes, but not band and/or chorus.

**Will virtual students be able to participate in classes at The Center?** Students that pick either the virtual or hybrid option will be allowed to take classes at The Center as long as transportation can be provided.

**What will the class size be for virtual students?** It will depend on the number of students that request FIVE at each school and each grade level. We will also match teachers from home schools when possible, but there will be some overlap.

**What will School District Five do if there is a positive case of COVID-19 on campus?** DHEC has established guidelines and protocols for COVID-19 identification and responses in schools. Visit [www.lexrich5.org/20-21reentry](http://www.lexrich5.org/20-21reentry) for details.

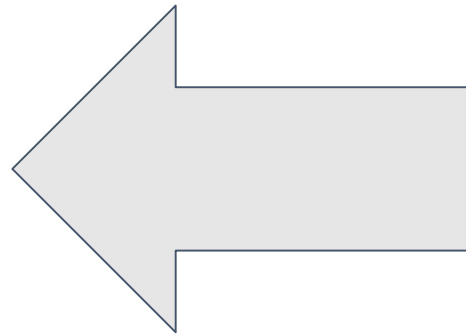

# Hybrid Plan for the Start of the 2020-21 School Year

- What **safety procedures and protocols** will be followed?
  - Safety procedures and protocols outlined in the School District Five 2020-2021 School Reentry Plan will be followed.
  - The Hybrid Plan will limit the number of students on campus, allowing for social distancing.
  - School District Five will require the use of face coverings for students and staff. The district will provide face coverings to all staff and will provide face coverings for any student who cannot provide their own. Face coverings must be worn while entering, exiting and moving throughout the building and during any congregant interactions inside or outside the classroom. Face coverings may be removed when students are seated at their work spaces. School District Five believes that when staff and students wear masks the spread of COVID-19 is significantly reduced.

# Hybrid Plan for the Start of the 2020-21 School Year

- 5K-1 – Devices have been secured
- 1<sup>st</sup> grade devices ready for beginning of school
- 5K devices scheduled to arrive within the first few weeks of school

# Hybrid Plan for the Start of the 2020-21 School Year

## Hotspots provided by the Office of Regulatory Service (ORS) under Act 142

- Households qualify for one hotspot based on three criteria:
  1. Currently have a student enrolled in school
  2. Currently have no internet service
  3. Income of 250% below poverty level
- Parents that qualify are currently being contacted; eligible households will be issued hotspots during the first two weeks of September.
- Hotspots currently will provide service through December 30, 2020 and are for educational use only.

# Hybrid Plan for the Start of the 2020-21 School Year

## Devices

- Chromebooks will be issued to all students in grades 1-12
- Kindergarten touch chromebooks have been ordered and will be distributed upon arrival which is expected during the month of September.

## Bandwidth increase

- The state has approved a temporary bandwidth increase for District Five schools to assist with increased demands of virtual learning.
- There is a cost share for the district but it can be reduced when no longer needed.

Parents and guardians with multiple children in District Five schools will have the ability to request that all of their children be placed in the same cohort. This request is made at the school level. The information was also collected in the reentry survey and shared with schools.



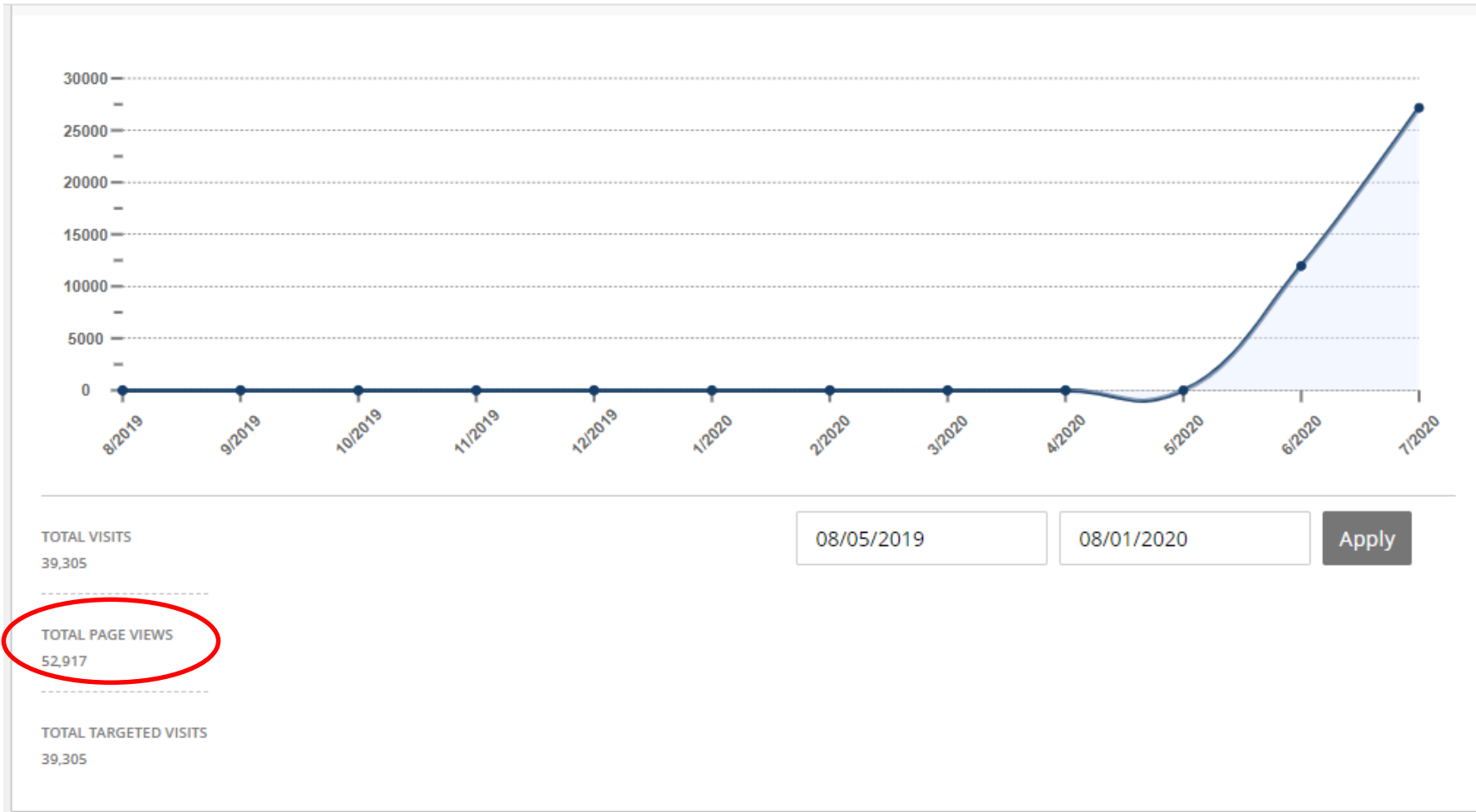
