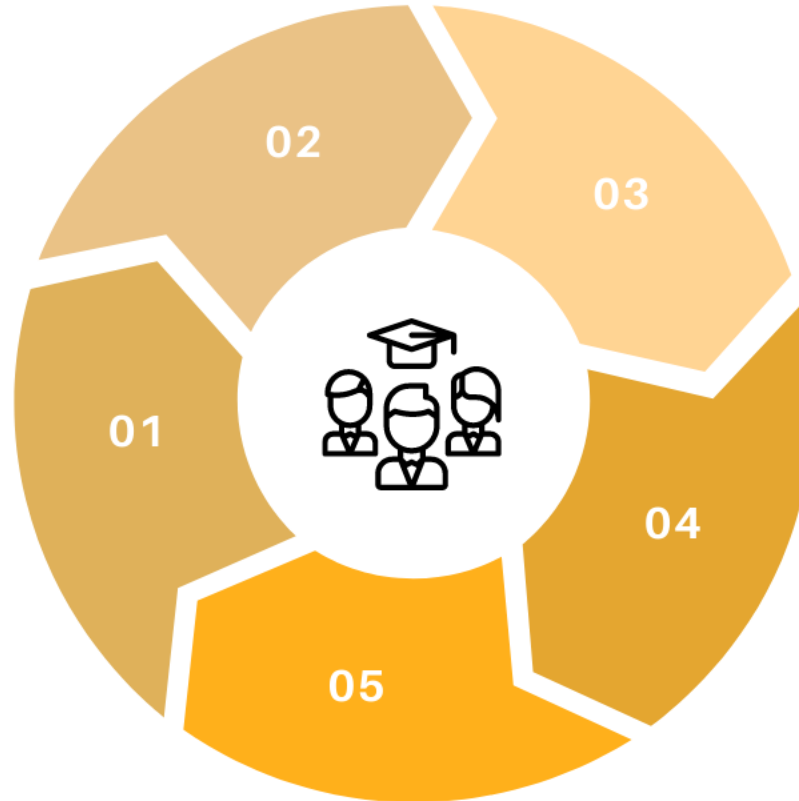
## FIVE GUIDING PRINCIPLES

The Two Week Cumulative Incidence Rate includes new cases reported in the past two weeks (August 26, 2020 – September 8, 2020) per 100,000 people. The rate describes recent incidence of COVID-19 infection to capture the potential burden of currently ill people who may be infectious and/or accessing healthcare.

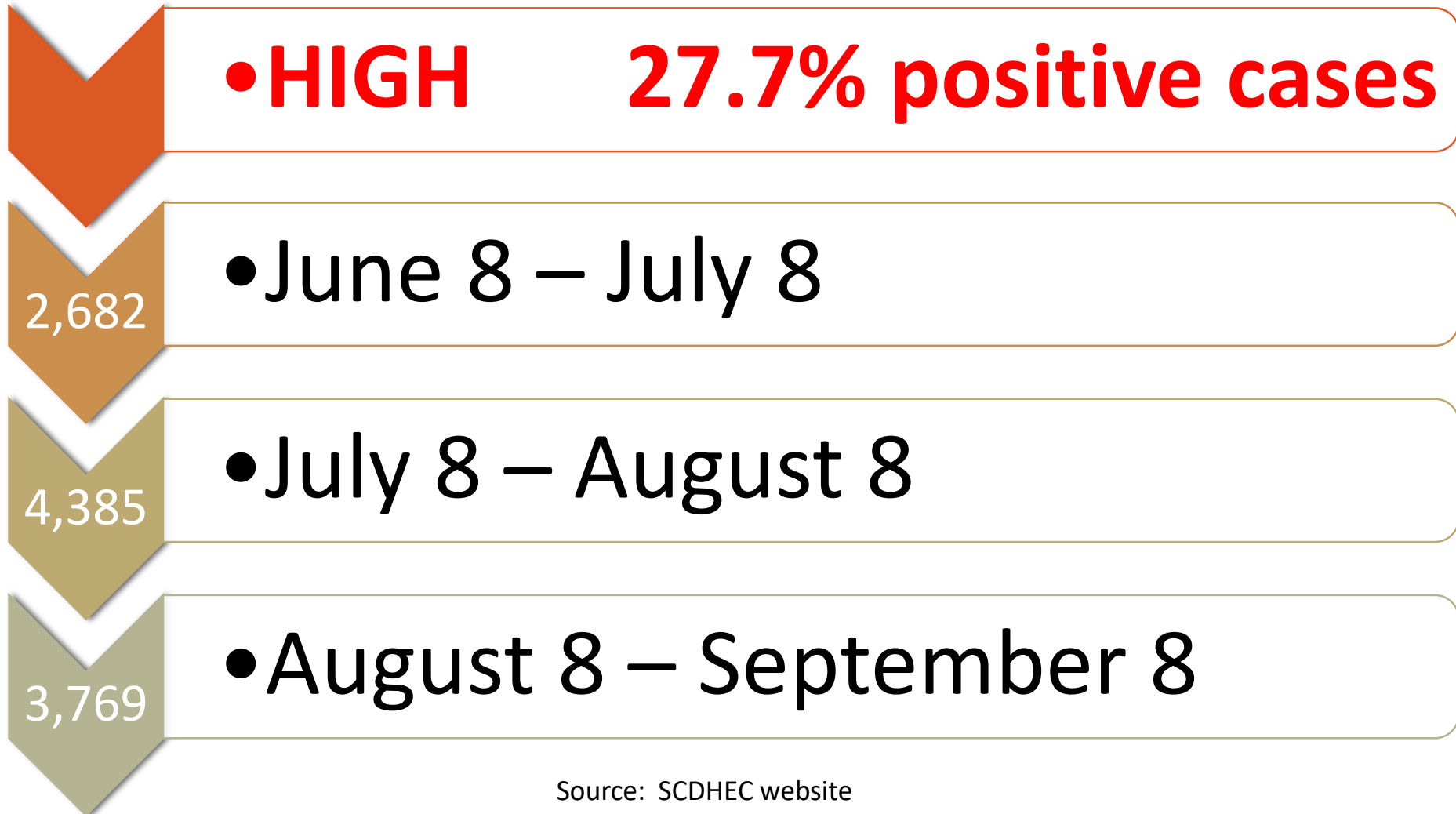
