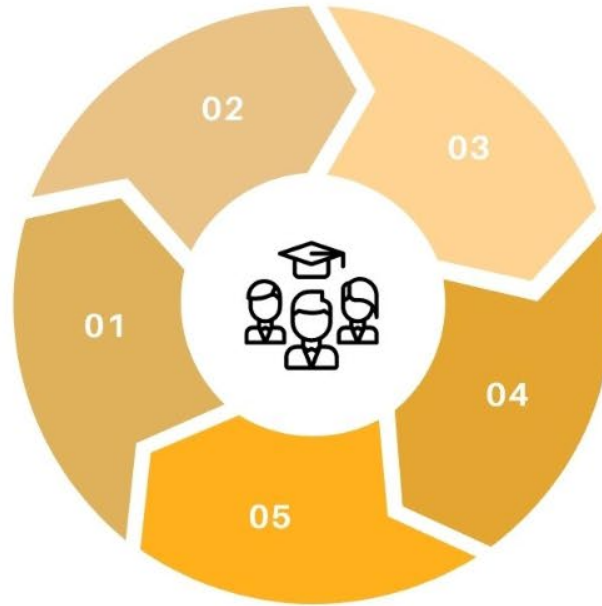
## FIVE GUIDING PRINCIPLES

May 19, 2021	Technical Assistance Session, SCDE
May 24, 2021	Grant Award Notification
June 24, 2021	Publish reopening plan publicly (on website)
June – August	District obtains REQUIRED public input on spending priorities based on allowable uses
August 24, 2021	Submit to SCDE the ESSER III application/district plan for review and approval
