2021 School Report Card



- SC Report Cards were released to the public on September 1, 2021.
- On March 26, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education [waived federal accountability requirements](#) and [granted flexibility in administering assessments](#) due to COVID-19.
- The results within Report Cards should not be compared to those of other years due to the testing limitations as a result of the pandemic.
- The results may be incomplete and may not be representative of the make-up of the state, district, or school population.

2021 School Report Card



- Includes assessment information from the Spring of 2021 (the first assessment data during the pandemic).
- Includes scores from SCPASS, SC READY, End Of Course, Ready to Work (R2W), and ACCESS.
- Does not include all data (SAT/ACT/AP).
- Does not include overall ratings of Excellent, Good, Average, Below Average, and Unsatisfactory.
- District 5 had a decline in the number of students tested due to the flexibility provided by federal accountability guidelines.
