 - School Administration
 - 1 assigned Clerical Staff Member
 - 4 assigned Certified Teachers
- Secondary schools are reporting a greater need for the support and greater use by students.
- We continue to monitor and make adjustments, as needed.

Implementation



- COVID Student Support teams began September 1, 2021.
- To date, teams are serving students in grades PreK-12.
- As of 9/10/21 at 9am District 5 has put into action COVID Student Support teams for:

Expectations



COVID Student Support Team Member:

- Support students by answering questions and/or serving as the liaison between the student/family and the classroom teacher and school.
- Communicate with the classroom teacher and the student/family and provide additional interventions as needed.
- Maintain logs of student attendance in the Google Meet sessions.

Expectations



Classroom Teacher:

- Post meaningful lessons, assignments, and due dates in Seesaw or Google Classroom to continue the learning process for all students.
- Recorded lessons through Screencastify, Flipgrid, Google Meet, etc. are encouraged when appropriate but are not required.
- Monitor attendance through submission of assignments.
- Maintain communication with the student/family during the quarantine period, ensure the student is engaged and completing work, and communicate with the assigned member of the COVID Student Support team.

Expectations



Student:

- Log into Seesaw/Google Classroom daily.
- Complete all assignments and submit by the due date.
- Email the classroom teacher with any questions or concerns.
- Work with the assigned COVID Student Support team member as needed.
- Participate in the COVID Student Support Google Meet sessions as needed.

Expectations



Parent:

- Ensure the student logs into Seesaw/Google Classroom daily.
- Ensure all assignments are submitted by the due date.
- Email the classroom teacher with any questions or concerns.
- Ensure the student works with the assigned COVID Student Support team member as needed.
- Ensure the student participates in the COVID Student Support Google Meet sessions as needed.

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Ways to avoid or shorten quarantine/isolation:

- Guardian provides a positive PCR test within the last 90 days for student.
- Guardian provides a record of a positive antigen test within the last 90 days for student. A positive antibody test will not be accepted.
- Guardian provides proof of full COVID-19 vaccination for student.
- Guardian provides proof of a negative test on day 5 or after. A student may then return to school on day 8 of quarantine.
