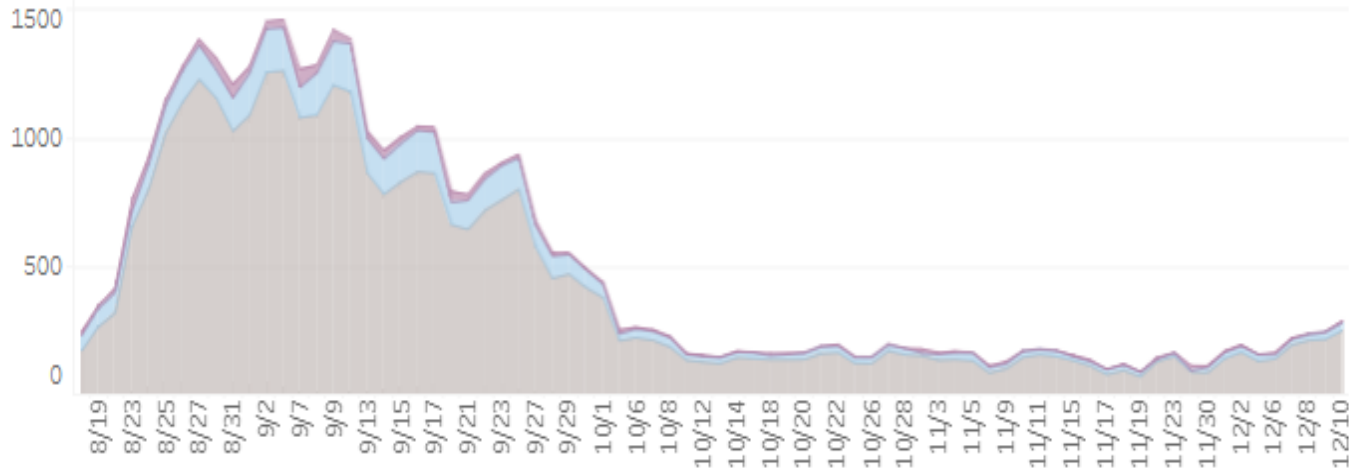

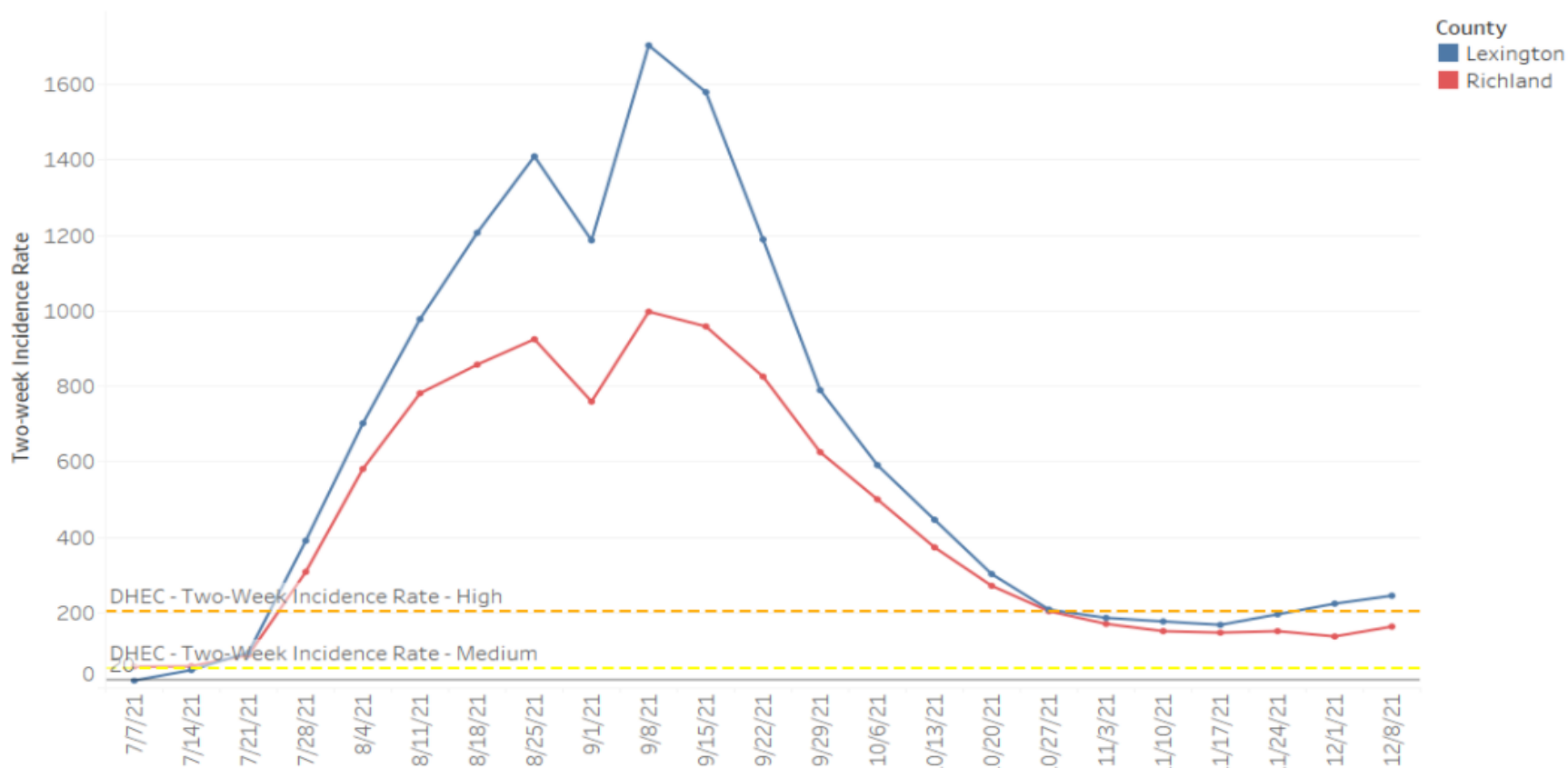

Classroom Mitigations

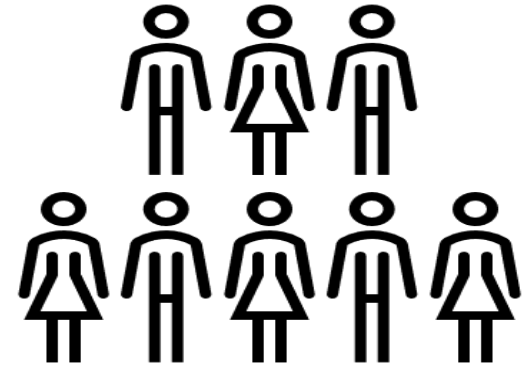
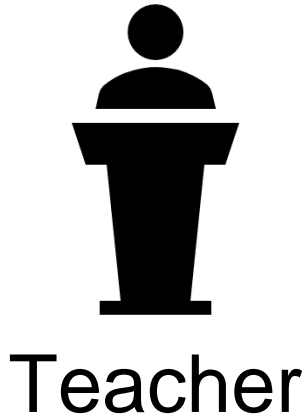

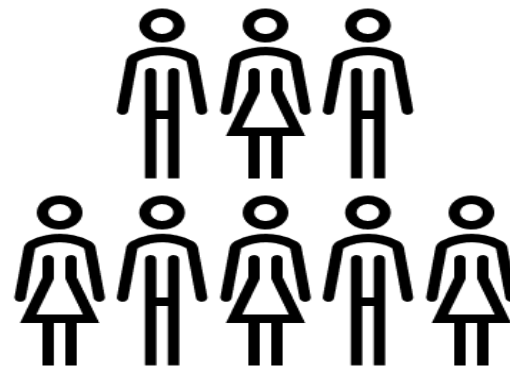

Pilot Teacher Support Model

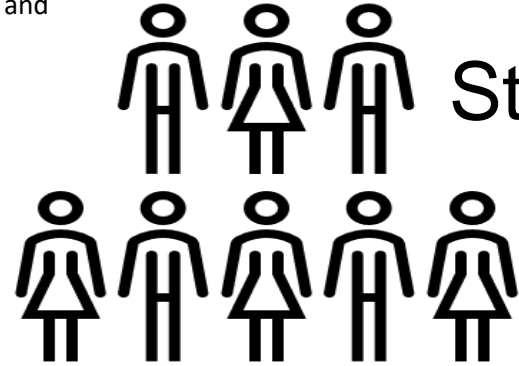
Under the new model, the teacher will have support with teaching academic deficits, and behavioral issues.

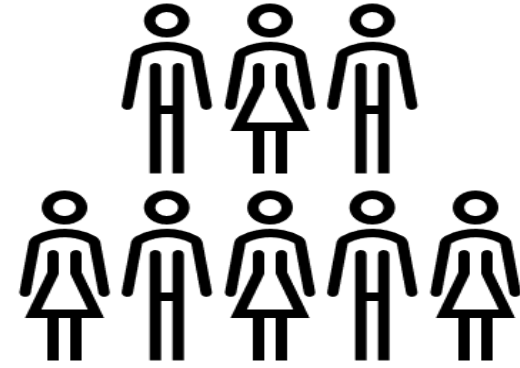
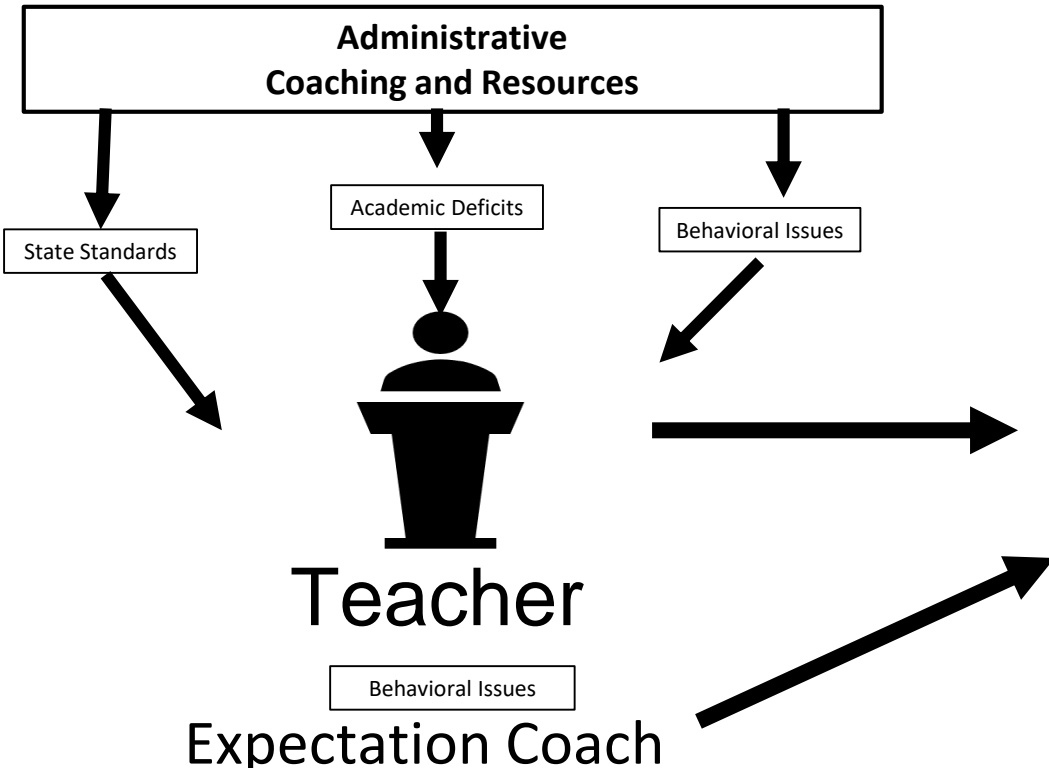
