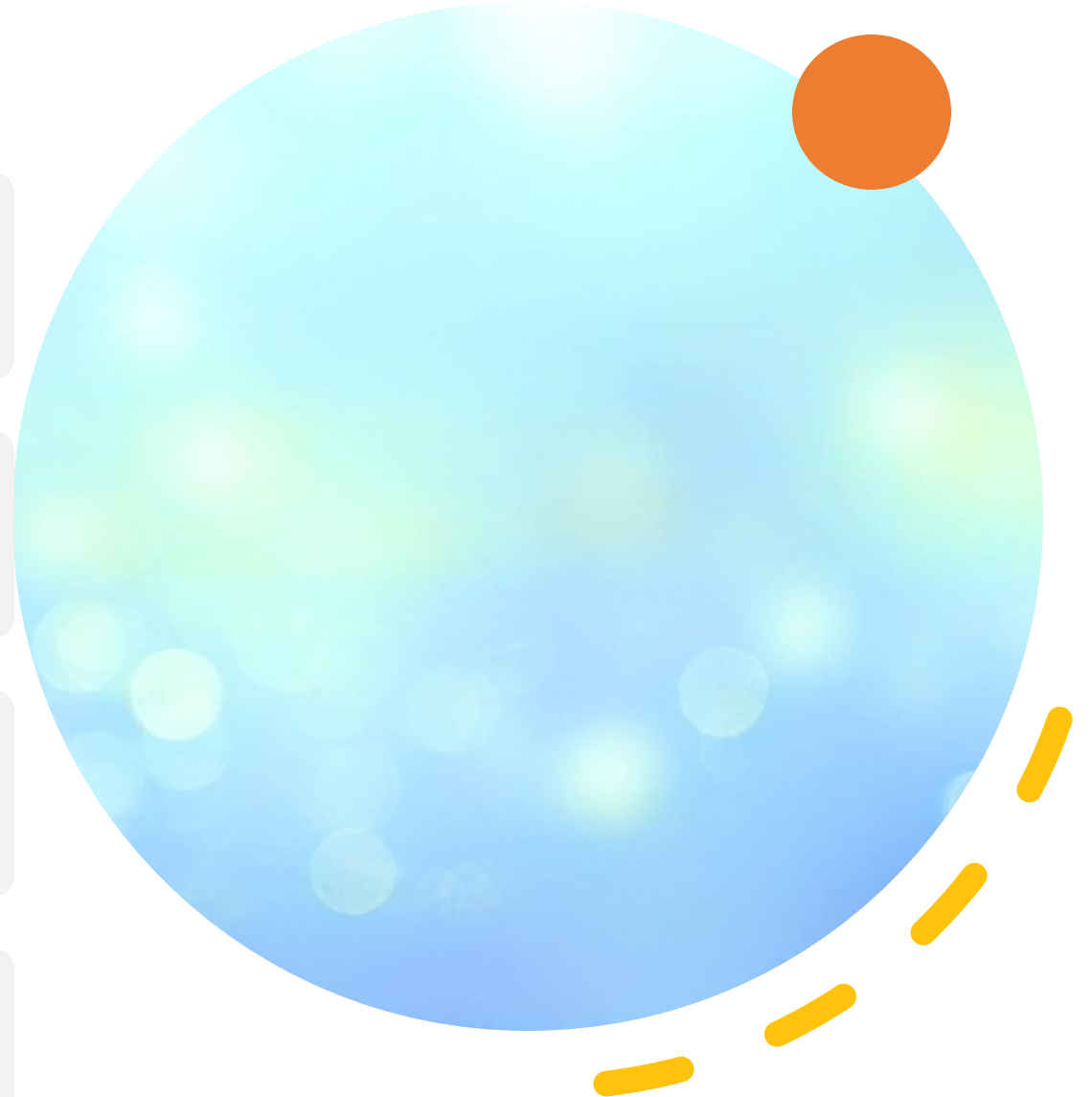

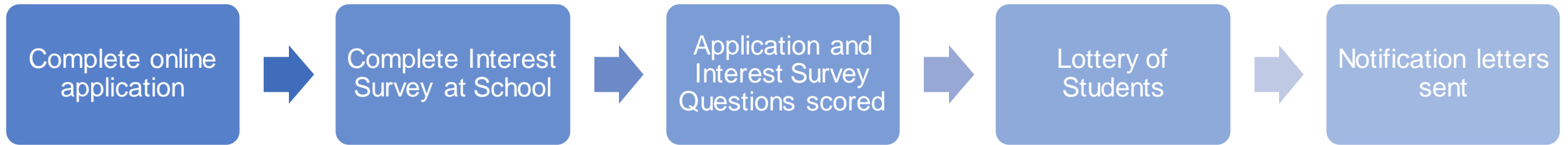

Application Process




Scores are made based on the following criteria:

- 40% Student interest expressed on Interest Survey
- 25% Application questions
- 28% Academic performance (6th/7th grades or 9th grade) as it relates to the program of choice
- 7% School attendance (6th/7th grades or 9th grade)

***Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, all student applicants will be credited the full 7% for attendance.*
