South Washington Alternative High School (SWAHS) offers an alternative learning environment with small class sizes that help students become career and college ready.

At SWAHS, all staff members are committed to helping every student feel supported and included. Teachers work to personalize student learning through one-on-one conversations and building relationships.

Each student has an advisor that acts as a mentor, and tracks their progress

SWAHS Students have a variety of career readiness options including enrollment in career and technical training at Northeast Metro 916 and earning credits through employment. In addition,

students take part in field trips focused on service learning, as well as

college and career preparation.

SWAHS also offers the Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) program, which helps students develop organizational skills and study habits that they can use to be

successful in college.



School and Community



109 students are enrolled at South Washington Alternative High School.

27 caring staff members work at South Washington Alternative High School who encourage and personalize learning for each student.



Curriculum Features

- The Achievement Lab at SWAHS is designed for students in grades 10-12 to complete coursework through a blend of teacher supported instruction, independent study and online learning.
- Work-based learning allows students to earn credits while working with a local employer.
- Post-Secondary Enrollment Option (PSEO) allows students to earn college credit while attending high school.
- Accelerated structure allows for credit recovery to be embedded within our day program.
- SWAHS offers middle school programming at CGMS and WMS.
