STUDENTS REACH HIGHER WITH LEVELS OF LEARNING

Union Catholic High School recognizes and values each student as an individual learner. As such, our curriculum is arranged into six different learning levels that set us apart from other schools and encourages individual strengths to yield success from our Freshman Foundations Program for students who require added academic support to our Distinguished Scholars where students can earn college credits while still in high school.

Students are never “locked” into a specific learning level; rather, throughout a student’s high school career he/she can move between levels based on academic performance. High achievement in one level provides the potential for students to meet the prerequisites for a more challenging learning level the following academic year.

Our collaboration with Virtual High School provides the opportunity for students to take non-traditional courses such as Veterinary Medicine, Screenwriting and Latin, to name a few of the hundreds of possibilities!

The Freshman Foundations Program at Union Catholic High School was created to help academically struggling students, and those with an IEP or ISP learning classifications, build a strong skills foundation so they can succeed in high school and continue on to college.

- Limited to 30 freshman with a maximum of 15 students per class for individualized support
- Emphasis on strengthening “the basics”, as well as organizational, writing and study skills
- Comfortable learning pace, adapted curriculum materials, and regular skills assessments
- One dedicated school counselor assigned to Freshman Foundations students from Freshman through Senior Year
- Not a “forever” program – after freshman year, students can advance to higher level classes based on performance and teacher recommendation

Our Freshman Foundations Program gives students an inspiring school environment and the jump-start he/she needs to perform well and add college to a list of future accomplishments.

The Synergy ParentVUE and StudentVUE portals provide secure, private, web and mobile access to student information, including current and historical grades and attendance data. Parents have one login and students have a separate login. The open grade book feature enables students and parents to monitor performance on individual tasks, including homework, quizzes, tests and labs, throughout the marking period.



The UC School Counseling Department has introduced NAVIANCE to the Union Catholic community. A comprehensive college & career planning solution, Naviance optimizes student success and connects what students do in the classroom to their future life goals. In addition to scholarship searches, students research colleges and careers based on their individual strengths, skills, and interests.

Dual Enrollment: Fairleigh Dickinson University
All of UC's Advanced Placement courses are available for dual-enrollment (high school and college credit) through Fairleigh Dickinson University's Middle College Program. Students who complete these courses successfully can transfer credit to the college of their choice.



Dual Enrollment: St. Thomas Aquinas College
Our arrangement with St. Thomas Aquinas College enables honor level students to study English 101 and 102 for high school and college credit.
