Write a list of things that you can do during a snowy day.

Illustrate your favorite scene from a book. Write a caption about what is happening in the scene.

Write an acrostic poem about something you would do during a snowy day!

SEL

Create your own positive affirmation. Write it down and post it somewhere you can see it every day.

Write three sentences describing how you could help a victim get away from a bully.

Write about one of the zones, then draw a picture showing someone in that zone.

Write a story about a time you had to apologize for a mistake.

Tell someone that you are thankful for them and why.

SPECIALS

Look out a window and draw the scene with as many details as possible. Tell someone at your home about your drawing.

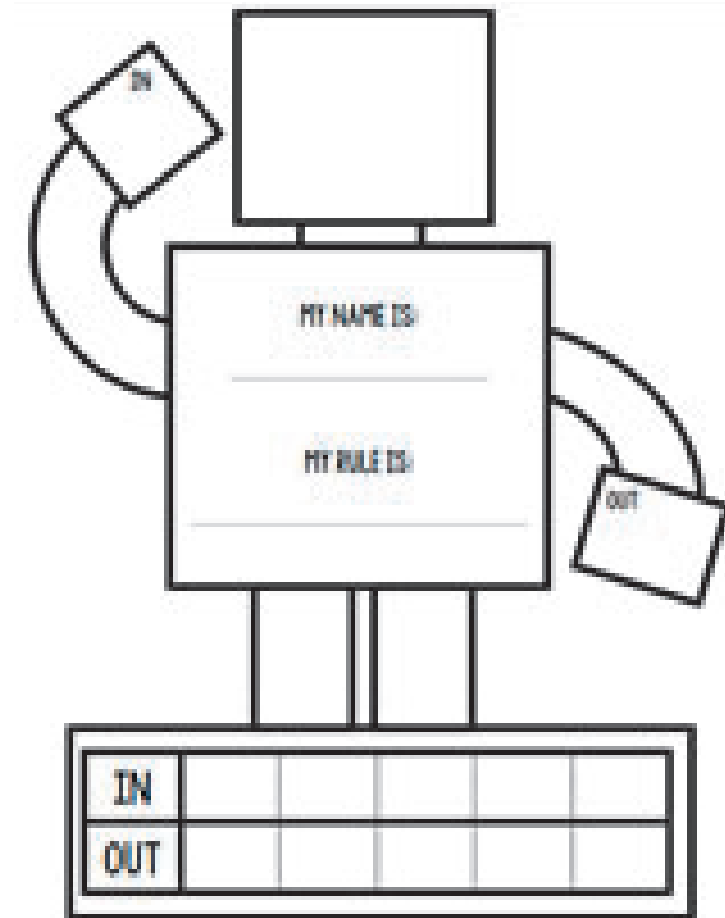
