Overview of Secondary Math Data, Deputy Superintendent Mrs. Ondrea Reed

• During her presentation, Mrs. Reed discussed the many ways the District assesses student progress including CAASPP data, SAT/ACT scores, A-G completion, and AP classes. Mrs. Reed shared the following highlights:

- Los Al USD is #3 in the county in Mathematics for Unified School Districts on the CAASPP Assessment
- LAHS SAT and ACT data is markedly higher than both state and national averages
- LAHS has increased in the number of graduates completing an AP Math Class (33%)
- Los Alamitos High School has **increased** in the A-G completion rate (80%)
