

Student Attendance at SHS Events

The following are expectations that Selah High School has developed for students attend SHS athletic contests. The Central Washington Athletic Conference has adopted these guidelines.

1. Students/children, grades **K-7** or younger must be accompanied by a parent/adult when admitted into the game/match/contest.
2. Children are prohibited from running around the stadium grounds, gymnasiums, or sports complex and are not to be left unsupervised.
3. Proper conduct is expected at all times. Children, students, and/or spectators involved in inappropriate conduct may be asked to leave the contest. Inappropriate conduct would include but not limited to throwing items, inappropriate language, insubordination, etc.
4. Items such as skateboards, roller blades, bikes, balls, noisemakers, bells, etc. are to be left at home. If they are brought to the stadium they will be confiscated.
5. Cooperation with game management/supervisor, district personnel, police and security officers is expected.

Individuals failing to comply with these expectations will be warned and removed from the contest. The privilege to attend future events may be in jeopardy.
