

**Primary Bus Stop** - The stop that is used most often by the student, typically one that is near their home.



**Secondary/Alternate Bus Stop** - A stop pre-approved for the student at another relative's home, a daycare, or a similar residence/childcare facility. The student's parents/guardians must request the stop in advance by communicating with Selah School District Transportation. The bus pickup/dropoff stop should be used on a semi-regular basis, not just once or twice per month (that would require a pass)

**Bus Pass** - For the occasional parent-approved and pre-communicated (to your child's school) stop to attend a classmate's birthday party or the once or twice per month stop at a relative's/carekeepers house/facility, there is the bus pass. A student must have a parent note to obtain a bus pass from their school office to get off at a different stop location on their usual or a different route (space permitting). Students must arrange for the pass with the school office at least two (2) hours before the end of the school day. Each school office will write the pass allowing your child to get off at a different stop. Your child will then need to present the pass to the driver of the bus they will be taking, room/space permitting.

**Shuttles** - Except for the flow of buses from SMS to SHS during each school day's first route runs, and from SIS to JCP for the second run, there are no "shuttles" between schools for students. Similarly, in the afternoon, the buses flow from SMS to SHS for the first afternoon routes, then on to JCP and SIS for the second, followed by the late afternoon routes for PreK/Kindergarten students. We will not be able to honor requests for "shuttles" from one school to another due to our new routing system and the number of students requiring busing to areas outside of the City of Selah limits.
