La Rosa Elementary: Be Kind

Students and adults are expected to be kind to each other. Examples of kind behavior include but not limited to:

- Listening to each other
- Talking politely and using appropriate language
- Using appropriate body language
- Using an appropriate tone and volume (even when angry)
- Avoiding words that are hurtful to others
- Accepting individual differences (including cultural, learning, appearance, other differences)
- Touching others' property only with permission
- Being mindful of other people's space
- Keeping confidential information private
- Treating school property with care and respect

Day 2 - Walking/Waiting in lines




What it looks like

What it doesn't look like



- Touching/kicking the walls

T Think of solutions that are safe and respectful

E Explore consequences what could happen if...

P Pick the best solution make your plan




Students will write a nice note to their Teacher. Give to the Teacher by the end of the day.



Show your Rascal Pride- Wear Red and Be Kind!

Friday- Dress to Impress - Compliments Day - Bring your compliments and share freely with others!






Crazy for Kindness - Crazy Hair and Socks Day
