WHAT IS GOING TO HAPPEN TO THE EXISTING SCHOOL SITES?

The decision making process for what happens to the existing sites won't occur until after a successful referendum on November 7, 2023.

The town controls how the properties will be used and will ultimately rely on current zoning, feedback from residents, and a thorough assessment of Town capital needs and priorities at the time to determine best use.

The properties won't be available until the opening of the new school in 2027 and the Town Council will lead the decision process at that time. Possibilities that have been discussed to date include a pre-k learning center, community center site, a potential for satellite library, or recreational programming.

ARE THERE SCHOOL FACILITY NEEDS THAT WOULD REQUIRE THE DISTRICT TO RETAIN SOME/ALL OF THE PROPERTIES?

The School will partner with the Town on this decision. There is a possibility that the District will ask that one school be reserved for a Pre-K solution, but the details are not currently known. It is suggested that this is a future discussion item as the Town works through a capital facilities plan to determine needs with the schools and consider the best ways to use the properties. This is ultimately a Town and Town Council decision, but the School District is pleased to participate in the process and have its needs and ideas considered.

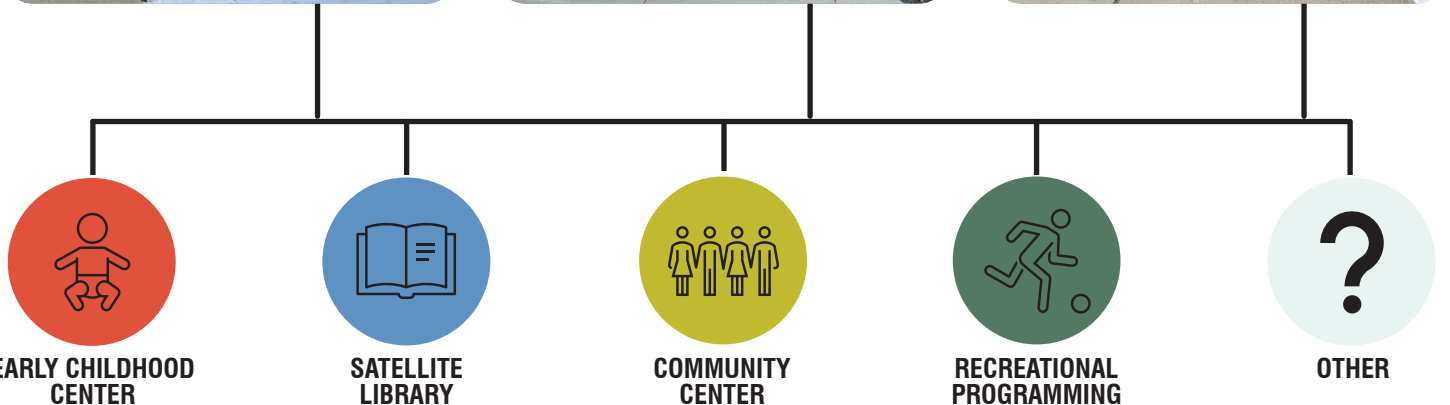
WHAT IS THE CURRENT ESTIMATED VALUE OF THE THREE K-2 SCHOOLS AND HAS THE SALE OF THEM BEEN CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE WAY TO OFFSET FINANCING OF THE NEW SCHOOL SITE OR CONSTRUCTION?

While noting that selling the current school sites has not yet been considered by the Town Council, according to the assessed value update in the spring of 2023, the current K-2 schools are valued as follows:

Blue Point: \$10,339,064

Eight Corners: \$10,470,680

Pleasant Hill: \$7,562,139
