What resources should be submitted?

Please submit materials that your school, district, or organization has developed, and that you give permission to reproduce. Please do not submit materials that you do not hold the rights to or that were developed by someone outside of your school district/organization.

Examples of resources to submit to the Repository are:

- DEI policies and plans
- Examples of how districts are utilizing the CR-S Education Framework
- Professional learning outlines and/or materials (slides, etc.)
- Student and family engagement resources and materials
- Materials to support DEI committees or advisory councils
