

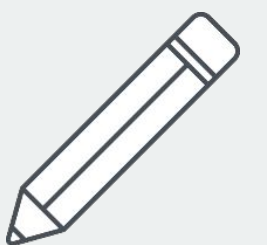

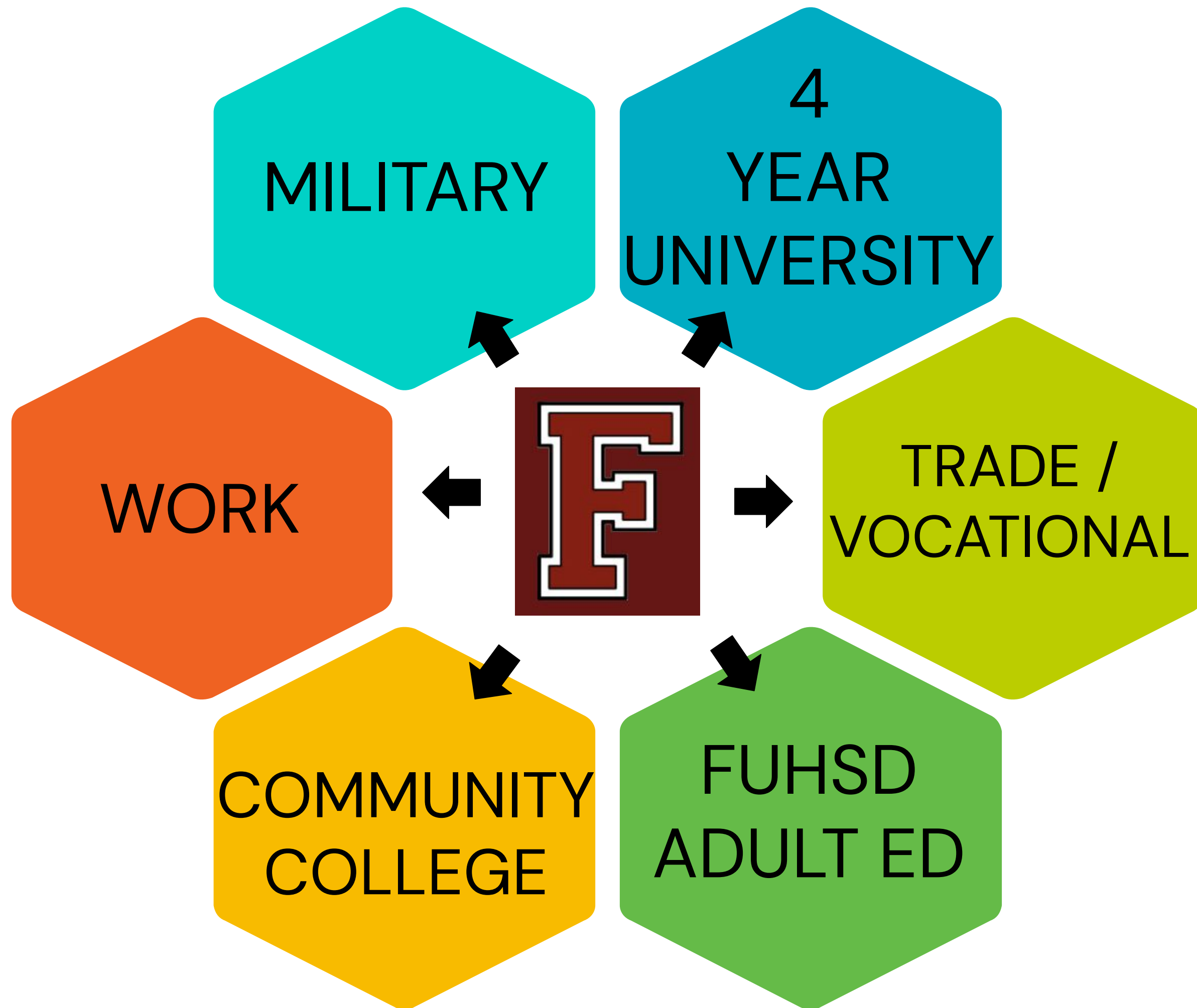
Maintaining balance, health, and rest.

-REQUIRED COURSES VARY

-GPA VARIES (USUALLY 3.0+)

-CHECK EACH SCHOOL RE: SAT OR ACT WITH WRITING

-CHECK EACH SCHOOL RE:

-PERSONAL ESSAYS

-LETTER OF RECS

- Research each school for requirements
- Letters of rec usually required
- Supplemental essays
- Extracurriculars, leadership, commitment
- Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)

College Testing

- ❖ **UC/CSUs will not consider SAT/ACT in admissions**
- ❖ Test optional vs. test blind
- ❖ Research each private college/out of state university to see if they will accept scores (or require them)
- ❖ If you plan to take SAT/ACT, test prep is recommended. Khan Academy offers free SAT practice
- ❖ May want to test in spring of Junior year (**March 18**)

Multiple Measures

There are many ways to determine which first-year GE English and math/qualitative reasoning (QR) courses are right for each student. Factors known as “multiple measures” are used to evaluate each student’s academic preparation in these subjects.

Please Note:

- The CSU no longer uses ACT or SAT examinations in determining admission eligibility for all CSU campuses.
- If accepted to a CSU campus, ACT or SAT test scores can be used as one of the measures for students to enroll in the appropriate mathematics or English (written communication) courses.

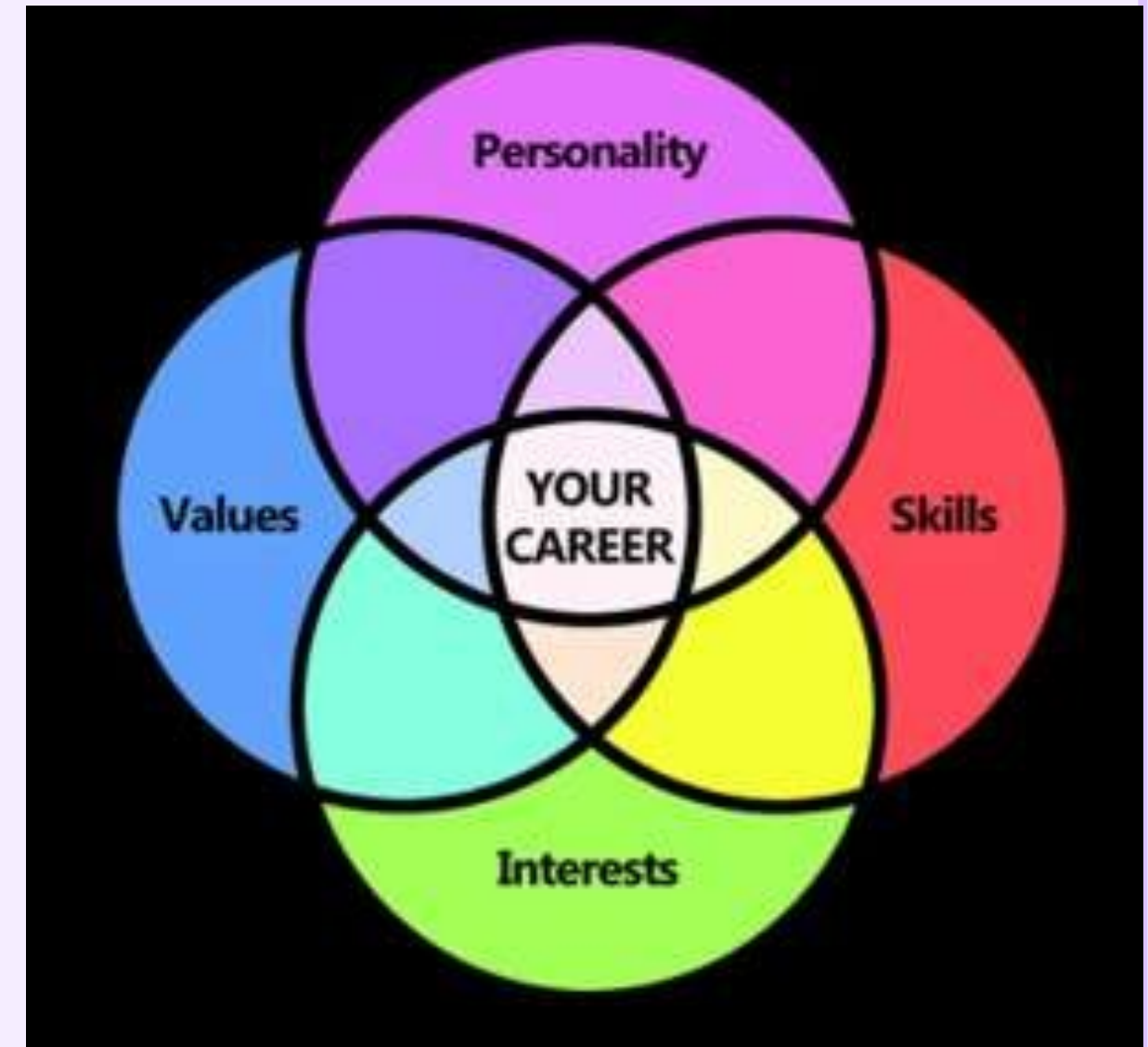

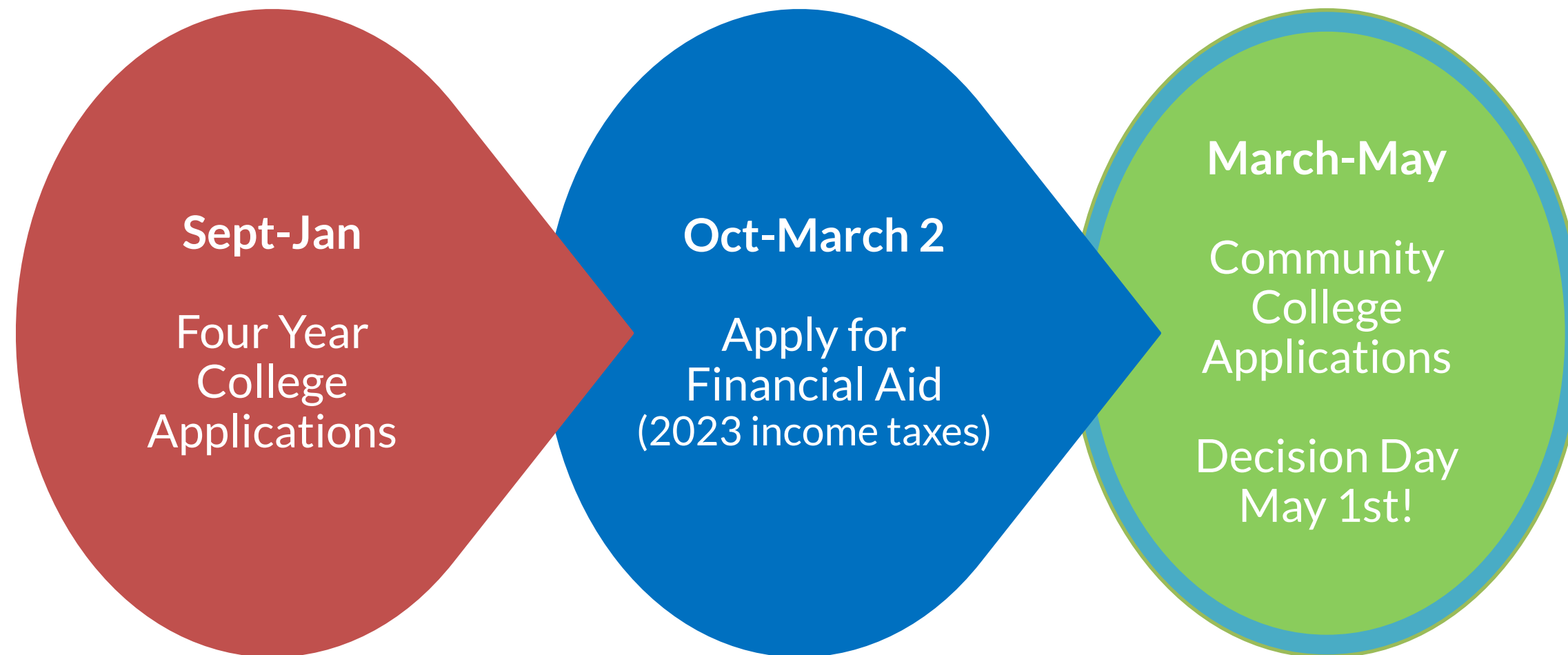

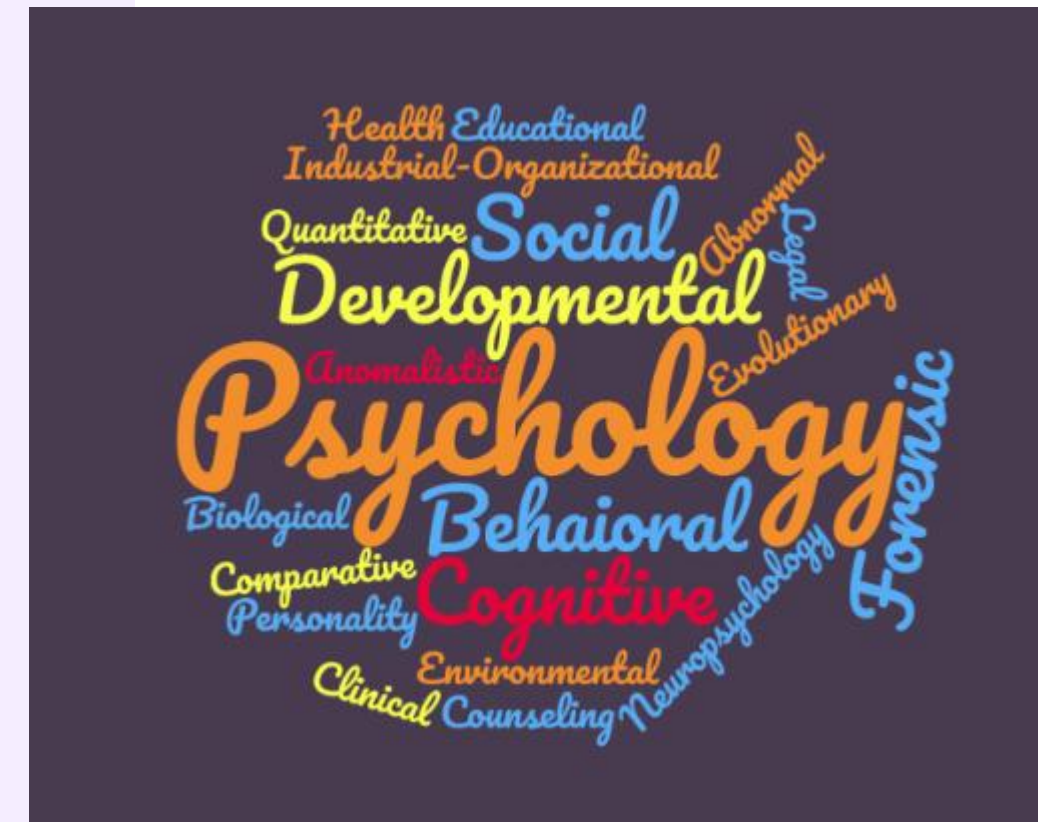

General Psychology

This course examines the factors influencing human behavior including biological and neurological basis of behavior, gender, lifespan development, cognition and consciousness, attention, sensation, perception, learning, memory, intelligence, motivation, emotion, stress, personality, psychological disorders and psychotherapy, social psychology, and applied psychology.

- Class starts on January 8th
- Students need to speak to their counselor if interested.
