## GUIDANCE & STUDENT SUPPORT

The purpose of the Guidance Program is to assist students with their academic planning so they can take full advantage of a range of options upon graduation from high school. FUHSD's Guidance Teams at each site generally include Certificated Guidance Counselors, College and Career Advisors and Administrators. These team members are often the first point of contact for students and families seeking information about FUHSD's high schools. The majority of guidance services are delivered through group presentations in the classroom or in evening presentations for students and their families. Guidance presentations occur throughout the year at each site with topics that include choosing a college and career, financial aid and course selection. The **Guidance team** is available to students and their families for individual appointments for support with:

- College to career planning (including a 4-year plan toward graduation);
- Facilitating positive, collaborative relationships with peers and teachers;
- Navigating the high school experience (including time management, involvement in extracurricular activities, self-advocacy, volunteer and internship opportunities); and
- Social emotional wellness.

The College and Career Advisors are the point of contact for college representatives, military recruiters, volunteer and internship opportunities. They also organize our district's College Fair each fall. College and Career Advisors support Naviance, our district's college and career planning tool, which provides students with personalized surveys and customized career and college exploration resources.

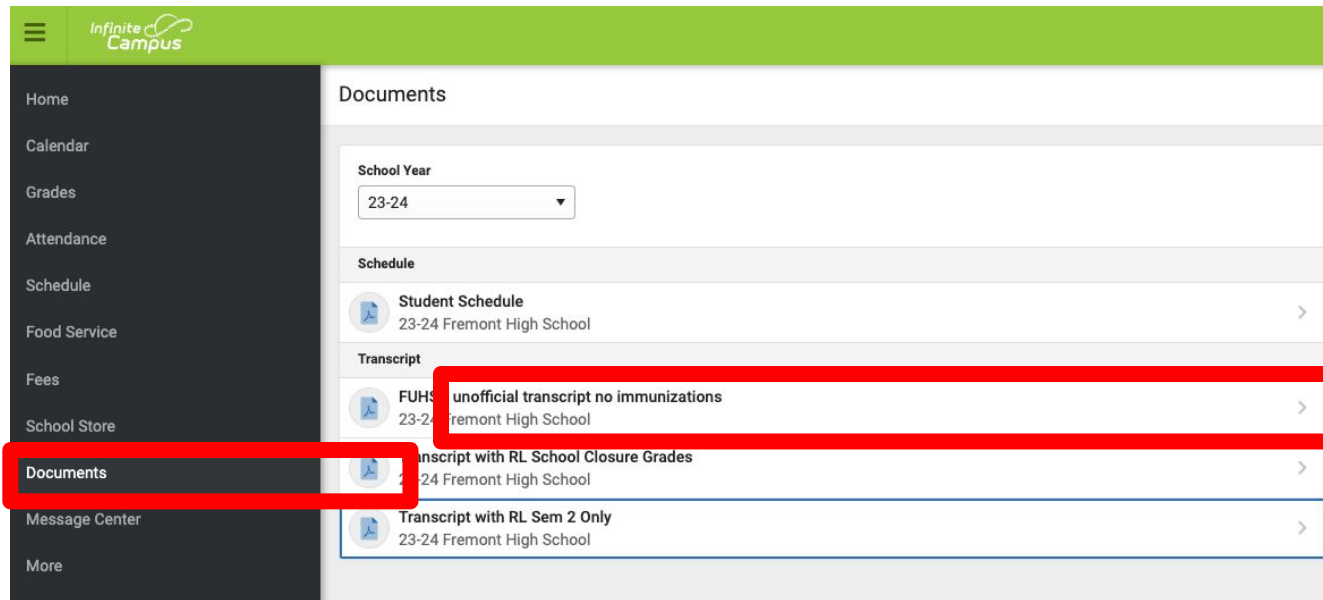

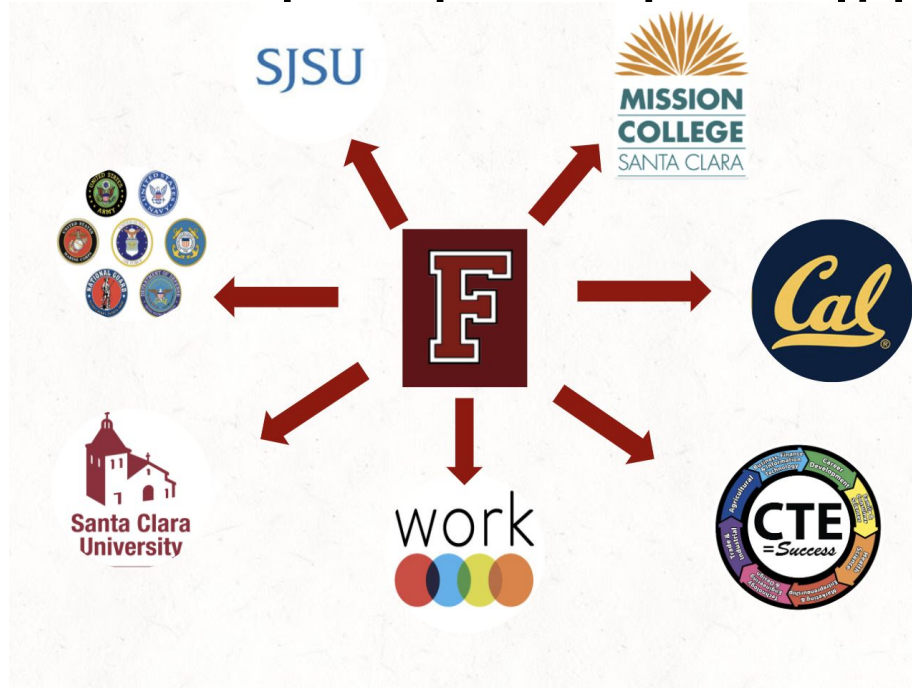

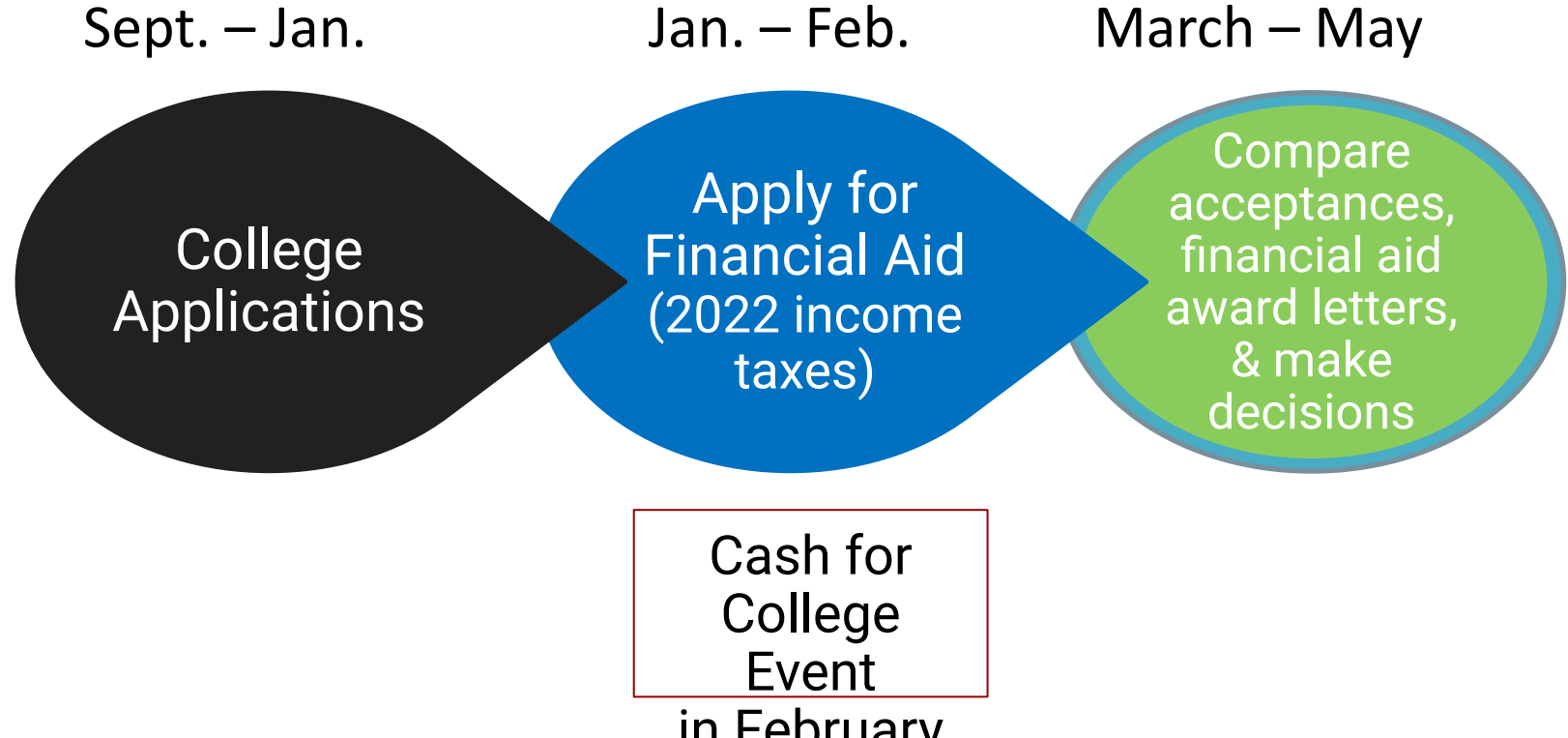

# REASONS TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

## (FAFSA/DREAM ACT)

- To get money to pay for college, a university, or trade/vocational program
- To be considered for FREE Tuition at the Community Colleges (CA Promise)
- To be considered for student loans (with typically lower interest rates), Work Study (to work on campus), and some private Scholarships
- Even if you think you may NOT qualify for any financial aid, if an unforeseen financial situation occurs, the FAFSA/DREAM must be filed to be reconsidered for financial aid
- It's a FREE application!





# AB 469- FAFSA/CA Dream Act-Opt Out

Graduation requirement

- a. Must complete either the FAFSA, the CA Dream Act, or Opt-out
- b. FAFSA, CADAA are due April 2nd (This year only)



# 2024-2025 FAFSA Key Changes

- Number of questions dropped from 108 to 46
- Students can list up to 20 colleges
- Online FAFSA available in 11 most common languages spoken in U.S.
- Paid preparation no longer permitted (ILLEGAL)
- Fewer FAFSAs selected for verification
- No more Parent signature page
- FSA ID required for both student and parent
  - Even if a contributor doesn't have a Social Security Number, they can still get an FSA ID to fill out their portion of the student's FAFSA form online.

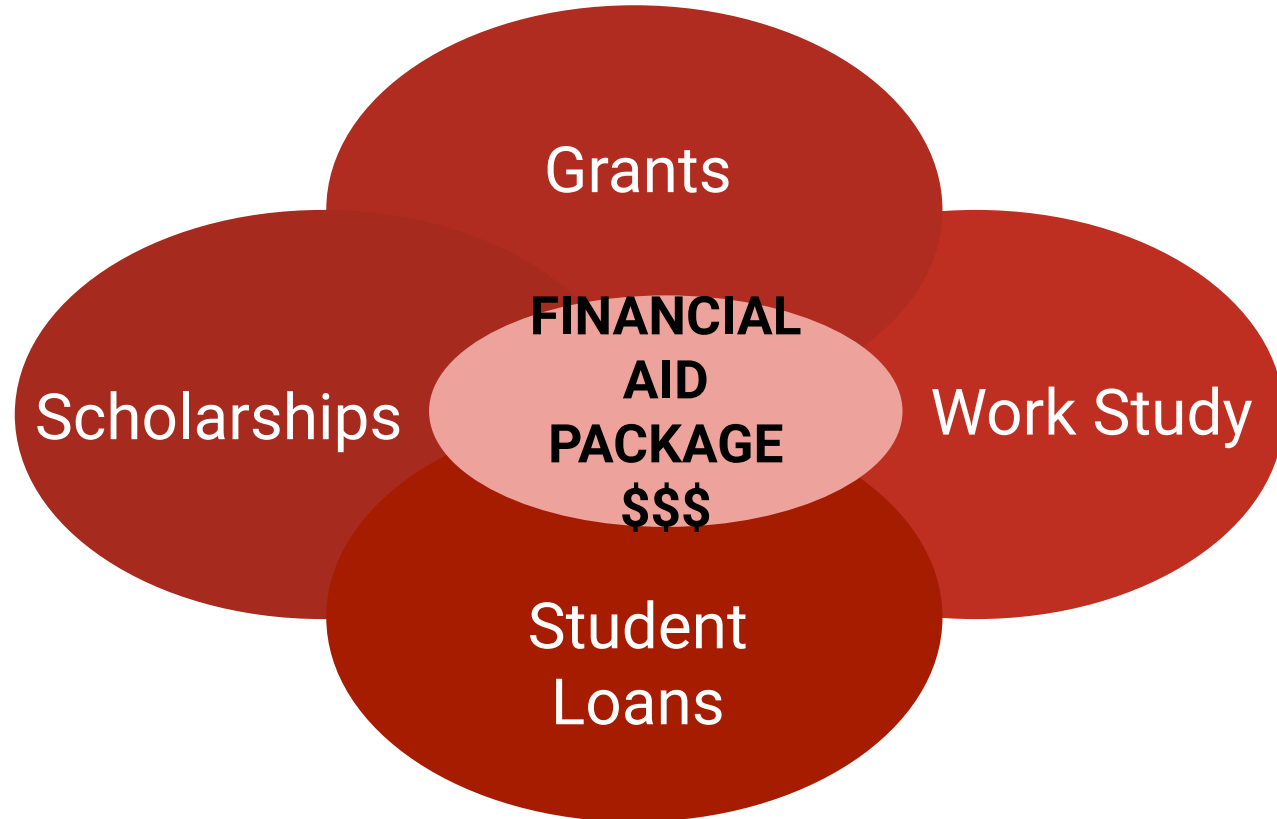
# 2024-2025 FAFSA Key Changes

- Contributor
  - Refers to anyone asked to provide information on a student's FAFSA form
  - Students or parents invite contributors to complete their portion of the FAFSA form by entering the contributor's name, date of birth, Social Security Number, and email address.
  - 45 days to complete
  - 7 day reminder to email

# 2024-2025 FAFSA Key Changes

- Consent
  - All students and contributors must provide consent for federal tax data to be: Transferred Used Shared
- What you need to know
  - If a student or required contributor **doesn't provide consent** to have their federal tax information transferred into the FAFSA form, **the student will not be eligible** for federal student aid— even if they manually enter tax information into the FAFSA form.

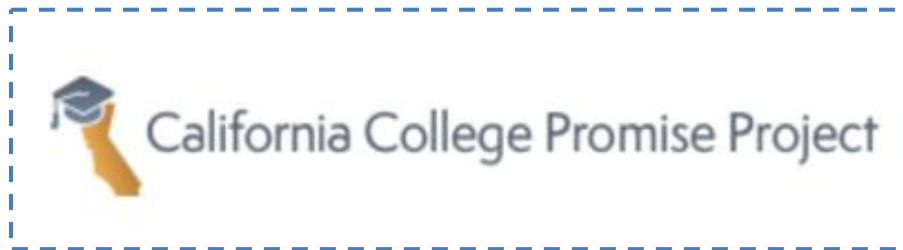

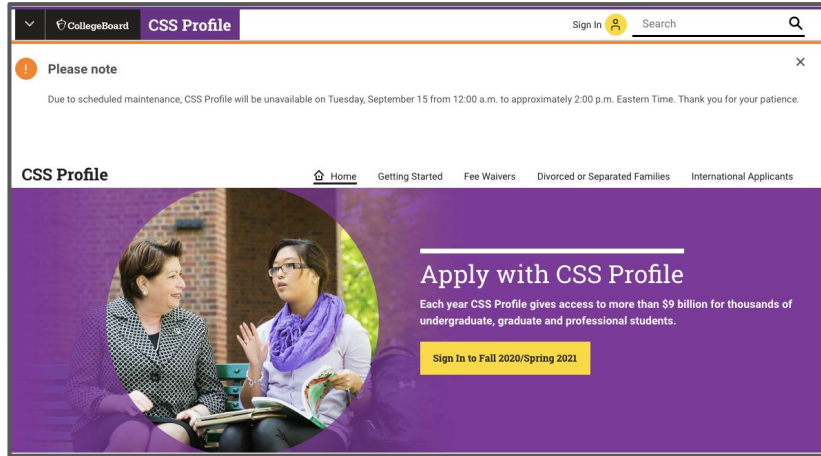
# The CA Promise Program at the CC = FREE \$\$\$



- California Community College Promise looks different at every college!
- Every college has specific eligibility criteria so check their websites
- They **all require the FAFSA/Dream Act** submission
- In general, the grant can:
  - Have enrollment fees waived-**Free Classes!**
  - Provide assistance with books & supplies
