

A Note from the Interim Principal

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for your recent visit to ELMS' Taste of the Arts evening. This event is always a fun-filled evening and well attended by our students and their families. I hope that you had the opportunity to meet with our talented Life Arts faculty and see "firsthand" the lessons and experiences which our students get to participate in.

In the month of November, our teachers will be using a tool called the Devereux Student Strengths Assessment, or DESSA. The purpose of the DESSA is to identify which social and emotional skills your student has already learned, and what skills he or she might still need to develop. Data gathered by this assessment will be used by school-based committees and teachers to make informed decisions to support social and emotional development in our school. The curriculum highlighted in today's letter is from Mr. Dan Bohman, ELMS Art Fellow. Please take a moment to review some of the creative projects and mediums he is incorporating into his lessons. Thank you, Mr. Bohman, for sharing and instilling such creativity into the projects and assignments.

Art is rolling along giving students the opportunity to explore their creativity using different mediums. Students in 5th grade are creating their own tile designs using radial symmetry and watercolor. They looked at tile and mosaic designs from Mexico, Portugal and Morocco. 6th grade students kicked off their first trimester with clay. Students created their own templates to create and glaze unique trinket trays using clay slabs and coils. Next, they practiced mixing and blending colors to explore color theory and paint creative color wheels. In anticipation for Native American Heritage Month in November, they are currently learning the history and tradition of making dream catchers using various materials. Grade 7 will be decorating the hallways with paper mâché pumpkins for October. They are exploring exaggerated emotions using different facial expressions in the pumpkins. They will then paint the pumpkins focusing on layered paint for a realistic depiction. 8th grade is in the middle of their large Pop Art Sculptures. Based on the Pop Art movement in the 1950s, students are constructing sculptures based on everyday objects not normally thought of as art and blow them up to a much larger size. They've created an armature using hot glue and cardboard and are now starting to paper mâché the structures to smooth out imperfections and to prepare it for painting.
