WINTER UNIFORM STARTS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST... UPDATED INFORMATION...



Beginning <u>Tuesday, November 1st</u>, all students in grades K-8 will be required to wear the regulation Winter School Uniform.

As a reminder, school shoes must be black, brown, or blue, and **sneakers may not be worn with the regulation Winter School Uniform**. All girls in grades K-8 must wear knee high socks or tights with the winter uniform.

PLEASE NOTE: If your child is cold during the school day, he or she should wear the navy long-sleeve banded bottom shirt, the navy ¼ zip performance fleece pullover, or the navy v-neck pullover sweater. **The navy hooded or navy crew neck Notre Dame gym sweatshirt may only be worn with the gym uniform.**

Keep in mind that we do go outside during the winter months. We check with the local weather service frequently to monitor the current temperature and wind chill, and we also walk outside to check the weather before sending students outside. During the winter months, please be sure to dress your child appropriately for outside recess (gloves, hats, scarves, etc.) and keep this in mind when getting ready for school.

Our uniform still stands as a symbol of pride and discipline for our school. Each student who wears it represents the high standard that exists because of your support and cooperation.


