

McKinney-Vento Homeless Information

Homeless Student Rights:

- Enroll in school immediately even without normally required documents, such as proof of residency, immunization/health records, etc.
- Participate fully in all school activities and programs for which he/she is eligible
- Continue to attend the school in which he/she was last enrolled even if you have moved away from the school's attendance area
- Receive transportation to and from the school or origin if requested
- Receive free school meals
- Get extra help with school supplies or other needs
- Extra support for youth who are on their own
- Help connecting young children with early childhood education services
