CLASSROOM NEWS

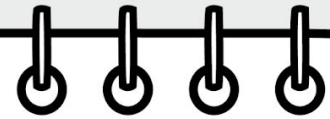
Math- We have just started Unit 3 which is all about fractions and converting fractions into decimals.
