

## **INDOOR AIR QUALITY COMPLIANCE**

Amity Regional School District, in compliance with CT State Law for air quality in schools, has an aggressive air quality program to ensure that all our air-handling devices are maintained and operate at peak level. In addition to the HVAC equipment, one part of our indoor air quality program is the Tools for Schools program. This program's purpose is to address other factors within the school building that can adversely affect indoor air quality. There is a committee that is made up of administrators, teachers, health district officials, custodians, administrative assistants, an industrial hygienist, nurses, and even students. We meet three times a year and annually do walkthroughs of the school to ensure that we are continuing to maintain the air quality of our buildings. Attached is a letter reminding all staff of the items that are not permitted in classrooms and offices as well as reminders of items that are not allowed per the fire code. Please review the list and if you have items outlined on there, we are asking that these items be removed immediately.
