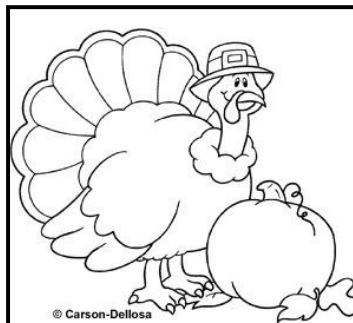
FCCLA Boo Bash 2023
