

## Juanita High School Student Success Summary

1. Ravens are **safe, respectful, and responsible**.
2. Attendance Policy
  - a. Students are responsible for regular attendance and active participation in each class. Any absences should be reported to the attendance office and students are expected to notify their teachers as soon as possible to make up any missed work.
3. Tardy Policy
  - a. Students are expected to have less than 5 tardies in a week. If students accrue 5 or more tardies in a week then students will be asked to a tiered tardy deterrent system that could include completing a feedback form, detention, parent/guardian meetings, and/or loss of privileges.
4. Hall Passes
  - a. Any student out of class during instructional time must have a hall pass issued by the appropriate staff member. Students must sign-out and sign back into their classrooms. Students are not allowed a hall pass during the **first five minutes and last five minutes of class**. Students are not allowed to use their cellphone or other electronic devices while using the hall pass.
5. Academic Connection Time
  - a. ACT is a scheduled period every Wednesday and it is tied to a student's 2<sup>nd</sup> period class. During this time, students can sign up to see a teacher to get extra help. Scheduling is done through FlexiSched. **All students are expected to remain in their 2<sup>nd</sup> period class if they are not scheduled to go to a different teacher.**
6. Homeroom
  - a. Homeroom is scheduled every Thursday. The purpose of Homeroom is to get important information about school, participate in school-wide lessons, and some fun activities we do throughout the school year. **All students are expected to participate in their homeroom.**
7. Class Schedules
  - a. Class schedules are available on Skyward and from your counseling center at the beginning of the year. Class changes are allowed only for approved academic reasons through the Counseling Office.
8. Off-Campus Lunch Passes
  - a. Juanita High School is a closed campus. Students who wish to leave campus at lunch must obtain an **Off-Campus Lunch Pass**. Freshmen are not eligible for Off-Campus Lunch Passes. All other students are eligible for a pass if they do not have any significant discipline or attendance issues. Students may obtain an Off-Campus Lunch Pass application form at the Attendance Office. The student must carry the pass with them whenever leaving campus and must show it upon request of a staff member. Students forgetting their pass will be denied the privilege of leaving campus.
9. Parking
  - a. **Visitor Parking:** The visitor parking in front of the field house is reserved for adult visitors only. Students should never park in visitor spaces and violators can be ticketed.
  - b. **Student Parking Applications:** Students must have no fines outstanding and must have submitted an application. More info is on the JHS website.
  - c. **Juanita High School Parking Policy:** All students who park their vehicle(s) on Juanita High School's campus during normal school hours must have a visible and valid Student

Parking Permit properly displayed on their vehicle. Violators are subject to fines and/or towing.

- d. **Lake Washington School District Parking Policy:** By issuance of a parking permit, the Lake Washington School District does not assume liability for any property damage to any private automobile parked on its property. The owner/operator(s) of all private vehicles accepts responsibility for their own property and agrees that they are parking at their own risk.

#### 10. Food Delivery Services

- a. Please do not order food to be delivered to the school during class time. If food is delivered to the school, it needs to be picked up during lunchtime. Students are not allowed to leave their classes to pick up deliveries. The school is not responsible for any food that is delivered.

#### 11. Cellphones and Personal Electronic Devices

- a. Cellphones and other personal electronics are not allowed during class time. **Cellphones and other personal electronics should be stored away in a backpack or another place designated by the classroom teacher.** When appropriate to instruction, classroom teachers may communicate to students that they are allowed to use their cellphones or other electronics. During class time, when using the hall pass, cellphones should not be retrieved from their stored area. Students may use their cellphones and other electronics during lunch and passing periods. Juanita High School is not responsible for lost or stolen cell phones, ear buds, or other personal electronic devices. Students bring these items at their own risk.

#### 12. Dances

- a. Juanita High School dances are school sponsored events intended for students enrolled at Juanita High School and/or Futures School. A guest may only attend a Juanita event if a student enrolled at Juanita or Futures School sponsors them. The sponsoring student is limited to one guest per event. The sponsor must obtain, complete, and submit the guest pass form prior to purchasing tickets. Once the students enter the dance facility they are not allowed to leave and enter again.

#### 13. Dress Code

- a. **Proper Dress/Clothing:** Students are expected to dress in a manner that is conducive to the educational environment. A student's dress or appearance may not present a health or safety hazard or create a material and substantial disruption to the educational process at school. Student dress shall not be gang-related, nor may it promote illegal activities or activities that violate school regulations.

#### 14. Soaring Raven Status

- a. When our students follow the RAVEN WAY they are most likely to soar in our community and help our flock thrive! Being a Soaring Raven allows for all the privileges of being a student at Juanita High School. This includes full participation in clubs, activities, and sports, off-Campus privileges for grades 10-12, ability to attend all after school events: dances, games, performances, etc., ability to access hallway passes during class time, and eligibility for parking passes.
