**UNDESIGNATED MEDICATION DISCLOSURE STATEMENT**

It is the policy of Minooka School District 201 to provide undesignated epinephrine auto-injectors, undesignated opioid antagonist, undesignated albuterol, and undesignated glucagon at each building, to be administered by a school nurse, administrator, or staff member trained in the administration of these medications to any student believed to be having an anaphylactic reaction, opioid overdose, respiratory distress, or severe hypoglycemia, respectively. The Illinois Public Acts regarding emergency epinephrine (P.A. 97-0361), Lali's Law (P.A. 99-0480), emergency asthma medication (P.A. 100-0726), and The Care of Students with Diabetes Act (P.A. 101-0428) provide civil protection for school employees who are appropriately trained to administer these emergency medications.
