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What is Expanded Learning?

“Expanded Learning” means **before school**, **after school**, **summer** and/or **intersession learning programs** that focus on developing the **academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests** of students through **hands-on, engaging learning experiences**.

Expanded Learning programs are **student-centered, results driven, include community partners**, and complement activities in the regular school day and school year


ELOP Student Eligibility and Family Requirements



Eligible Students must be identified as:

- A student who is a foster youth or experiencing homelessness
- A student who qualifies for Free or Reduced-Price Meals (FRPM)
- A student who is an English Learner


