

Verona Area High School Youth Apprenticeship (YA)



In a **Youth Apprenticeship**, students get a jumpstart on their future career, combining classroom learning with valuable hands-on workplace experience.

- 11th and 12th grade students can participate in Youth Apprenticeship.
- Apprenticeship takes place over the course of the school year, and into summer:
 - 450 hours of paid work = 2 elective credits at VAHS
 - Hours can be worked during the school day (if it works with both your VAHS schedule and your employer's schedule)
 - Pathway Career Related Coursework: 1 high school credit, or 3 college credits through VAHS, DCSC or Madison College
