

The school counselors wanted to tell you about the career artifacts that are required by the state. These are activities to help kids learn about jobs and about themselves in terms of their interests and strengths. 6 artifacts are necessary by the time they head to middle school. We have an exciting new computer program called Smart Futures which will be used in grades 1–12 to complete these activities. Counselors will be working with classrooms once or twice a year on Smart Futures. If you have any questions, feel free to contact your respective counselor.

A friendly reminder that attendance is highly essential with academic success. When a student hits 3 unlawful absences, letters will be sent home for informational purposes. Once a student hits 6 unlawful absences, a meeting with the counselor, principal, and social worker will be held. In addition, 10 or more excused absences results in any additional absences requiring a doctor's note. If a certain situation arises and you need assistance, please reach out via phone or email.

Health Room News

- Dental forms went home to all 1st and 3rd grade students. Please take them with you to your child's next dental visit and return to the health room by May 3, 2023.
- We will be starting hearing screenings in November. All students Pre-K to 3rd grade will be checked. If there are any concerns the nurse will reach out to you directly.
- Students must be fever (less than 100) vomit and diarrhea free for at least 24 hours before returning to school.
- Please ensure you update your phone numbers and emergency contacts in PowerSchool so
 we can easily reach you in the event of an illness or emergency.
- Medication during school hours:
 - o Parents need to bring in the original container with pharmacy label
 - Medication Authorization Form can be filled out with nurses when medication is dropped off
- Parents of young students please send in a change of clothing in the event of bathroom accidents. Label items and place in a large Ziploc bag to keep in your child's locker.


