IMMUNIZATION
REQUIREMENTS

IN GEORGIA, ALL CHILDREN BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2002 WHO ARE ATTENDING 7TH GRADE, AND CHILDREN WHO ARE NEW ENTRANTS INTO A GEORGIA SCHOOL IN GRADES 8 THRU 12, MUST HAVE RECEIVED 1 DOSE OF TDAP VACCINE AND 1 DOSE OF MENINGOCOCCAL CONJUGATE VACCINE TO FULFILL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS.

ALL STUDENTS ENTERING OR TRANSFERRING INTO 11TH GRADE WILL NEED PROOF OF A **MENINGOCOCCAL BOOSTER SHOT (MCV4)**, UNLESS THEIR FIRST DOSE WAS RECEIVED ON OR AFTER THEIR 16TH BIRTHDAY.

MENINGOCOCCAL DISEASE IS A SERIOUS BACTERIAL ILLNESS THAT AFFECTS THE BRAIN AND SPINAL CORD. MENINGITIS CAN CAUSE SHOCK, COMA AND DEATH WITHIN HOURS OF THE FIRST SYMPTOMS. PROTECT YOUR CHILDREN AND OTHERS FROM MENINGITIS.
