This month, classroom families spent time continuing our learning about feelings. We worked on describing different feelings, thoughts, and actions that may occur in response to a situation. Students worked on describing how thoughts can influence feelings and actions and that people can feel, think, and act differently in the same situation. Learning to take the perspective of others is an important life-long skill that helps build relationships with other people. Students participated in various activities and determined how they would feel, think, and act in a certain situation and then compared their responses to others.

We will continue to strengthen our understanding and regulation of our feelings throughout the year.
