1. Athletic Committee

The Athletic Committee met in June 2023.

In attendance were: Vishal Patel, Shannon Peng, Brian Rivera, Edward Aldarelli, Ed.D., Argiris Hristofis, David Sandaal

Key Takeaways:

1. Volleyball: The school district is ready to implement Volleyball as a sport in all four middle schools for boys and girls.

- a. Volleyball courts in all middle schools are updated to meet volleyball tournament requirements
- b. Edison enrolled 4 middle school girls and 4 middle school boys teams in the middle school volleyball league in the GMC with a total of 13 teams.

2. Cricket: The school district is ready to implement cricket as a co-ed intramural sport in all middle schools and as a co-ed club sport in both high schools

Discussions:

Middle School Volleyball – Interscholastic Sport: (Provide details for the practice schedule, game schedule, GMG Registration, number of teams, selection criteria, etc.)

- As of 6/6/23 Edison enrolled 4 middle school girls teams and 4 middle school boys teams in a middle school league in the GMG. The girls are slated to be one of 13 teams, set to begin in the Fall of 2023. The boys will begin play in Spring 2024 with the same amount of teams. All teams will play every other team once, making it a 12 game schedule.
- All 4 middle school gymnasiums are going to be striped and holes bored for the volleyball systems. The work is scheduled to begin on four consecutive Saturdays, starting on June 17^t and ending on July 8th.
- Waiting to hear back from Sports Paradise on a price quote for girls and boys uniforms. All teams will be provided with one pair of short and 2 game jerseys (one home and 1 away).
- Pending ETEA/BOE Contract negotiations, looking to post for 4 girls and 4 boys middle school coaching positions in late June/early July 2023. Selection criteria determined by coaching staff.
- Practices and games will be held on weekdays, between Monday and Friday. There are no Saturday games. There will be an intramural tournament for the girls on a Saturday in mid-November, and for the boys on a Saturday in late May. Both tournaments were well received. They were very organized and well-run.
- 20 sets of uniforms will be ordered for all 8 teams (4 boys/4 girls). With one coach per team, 15 to 18 athletes per team is an optimum number to ensure proper supervision.

Cricket Status: HS Co-Ed Club Cricket: Provide details for the ball used, practice schedule, game schedule, number of teams, selection criteria, club registration, etc.

Winter 2023 – Interest Meeting – via Coach, Club Registration via Google Classroom

Spring 2023 – Preseason/Tryouts – March 18-28, 2024 – Selection Criteria – Up to the coaching staff; Practices – 3 times per week (up to the coach’s schedule), after school; Game/Tournament Schedule – Saturdays 9:00 AM – 4/13 – Game 1; 4/20 – Game 2; 4/27 – Game 3; 5/4 – Game 4; 5/11 – Game 5; 5/18 – Tournament Start (3 seed vs. 6 seed, 4 seed vs. 5 seed); 1&2 seeds get a bye; 6/1 – Semis; Week of 6/3 – Finals (Can be played after school based on facilities or wait until 6/8).

Middle School Co-Ed Intramural Cricket; (Provide details for the ball that will be used, practice schedule, game schedule, number of teams, selection criteria, club registration, etc.)

Middle School Cricket (Intramurals 2023-2024)

- Edison has advisor stipends as past practice (\$610 for 18 hours of instruction)
- John Adams and Woodrow Wilson Middle Schools currently run a cricket intramural in the morning. Students arrive before school to participate.
- Cricket intramurals can culminate in a Saturday tournament, similar to how volleyball ran this school year.
- Intramurals can not interfere with after-school sports. The current format of AM only is also not ideal. Solution – Run the intramurals after the spring season is complete (mid-May to late June).

Update:

- Middle School intramurals run as above – based on student interest, advisor availability and no cuts.
- Budget for a coach/advisor for a spring tournament series
- Keep only 20 students-athletes to compete
- Tournament Season Series – Begins May 20th (after Middle School sports are completed)
- Practice May 20th through June 7th, 2-3 times per week
- June 1st – Herbert Hoover Middle School vs. Thomas Jefferson Middle School, followed by John Adams Middle School vs. Woodrow Wilson Middle School
- June 8th Consolation Game followed by Winner of South vs. Winner of North

Discussion – How do we improve sports coaching across the board?

- Stipend amounts need to be increased to attract externally qualified coaches
- Internal coaches/educators should be moved to the high school for relationships, academic accountability, and access.
- Sports Coaching Efficacy – Increases with years of experience; want to find people who want to build legacies.
- Sport-specific professional development – continue to support coaches attending external PD.

2. Curriculum Committee

The Curriculum Committee met in May and June 2023

In attendance were: Vishal Patel, Biral Patel, Shannon Peng, Jingwei “Jerry” Shi, Edward Aldarelli, Ed.D., Gail Pawlikowski, Baninder Goomer

Key Takeaways:

1. High School Program of Study for Computer Science Classes is updated to remove the dependency between Python and Java.
2. Middle school Schedule changes detailing the problem, challenges, solution and benefits will be published on the Edison School Website before school starts in September 2023.
3. The school district is planning to enable online sports form submission by December 2023.
4. School administration explored the possibility of offering additional electives to high school freshmen but determined that it cannot be done in the 2023 school year due to space constraints.

Discussions:

1. Program of Study Update About Computer Science and Other:
 - Computer classes were renamed to make it clearer that they are not based on a particular language, but rather a skill level. Python and Java were renamed Programming I and II. There is no requisite for Programming I. Students must demonstrate some computer science skills to skip Programming I.
2. Publish a webpage about middle school schedule change with details info that is hard to be misinterpreted (Problem, Challenges, Solution, Benefits of the new solution, Efforts that administration made to come up with solution, WIN period details for each grade, next steps). Nice to have a draft to review during the meeting.
 - Building principals met with the parents who expressed concerns regarding the schedule. The conversations were extremely productive and clarified many of the misconceptions that surrounded the schedule. Next steps – work with the newly appointed director of communications to get this information out in a cohesive and clear way -webpage/flyer, etc.
3. Possibility of offering additional electives to high school Freshmen
 - After reviewing this with the counselors, building principals, etc. there is not enough space to offer an additional elective at this time. This is accurate for both high schools presently.
4. Elementary school platooning
 - We currently offer platooning at elementary schools; however, this is a building-based decision that is done in concert with the building principal and the teachers. Not all schools are participating. Factors that contribute to a school’s decision to offer platooning include but aren’t limited to: i) Teacher relationship and content specialty; ii) Number of sections at the grade level; iii) Comparative discipline
5. ChatGPT research – How do we embrace or reject ChatGPT in the Edison School district?
 - As educators, we need to adapt to the way technology and AI affects our students’ learning. Embracing and using ChatGPT is more about promoting a culture for learning than it is about cheating or having this platform write your term paper. ChatGPT can be used as an example for high quality writing, creating meaningful questions and learning prompts for teachers.
6. Status of Online Sports Health Form Submission
 - We have continued to look into this. The program is with the submission platform isn’t something we can do right now as we would still need to get the paperwork to our school physician (printed). Mr. Barca and Mr. Benedict are working on an SOP and some messaging to help parents make the process smoother.

3. Finance and Facilities Committee

WHEREAS, as good stewards of the taxpayers’ money, over the past three years, the Edison Township Board of Education has held the line and not increased the amount in school taxes levied upon on Edison residents; and

WHEREAS, in contrast, the Edison Mayor and Council is considering the adoption of a budget on July 24, 2023 that would increase the amount to be raised by local taxes for municipal purposes from \$103,044,983.43 to \$106,329,679.85, an increase of 3.2% year over year; and

NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED: that the Edison Township Board of Education hereby encourages the Mayor and Council of Edison Township to join the Edison Township Board of Education in holding the line on taxes levied upon Edison’s residents as part of the 2023 budget year.

BE IT FURTHER
RESOLVED: that the Edison Township Board of Education expresses its opposition to the budget as introduced by the Mayor and Council of Edison Township and urges it to reconsider the proposed tax increase upon Edison residents contained in same.

BE IT FURTHER
RESOLVED: that the Board Secretary shall transmit a true copy of this Resolution to the Mayor and Council, Business Administrator, and Township Clerk of Edison Township.
