Pick-Up/Drop Off


I Chat Process

To ensure that we have consistency in the way we process iChat for field trips or Guest Speakers, etc and provide the results back in an expedition manner please note the following:

- iChat forms can be picked up from the academy office and/or main office from the principal.
- iChat forms are due to the Academy Principal no later than 5 days prior to the field trip.
- iChat forms must be submitted with valid state issued identification.
- Approved applicants will be notified via Deanslist with in 72 hours of the field trip.
- Non-approved applicants will receive a follow up phone call no later than 72 hours of the field trip.
- Leaders will receive a Google sheet with approval or non-approvals 48 hours prior to field trip and ensure homeroom staff/staff are informed (also will follow up with parent).




