FIRE SAFETY WEEK

Fire Safety Week is October 8th -October 14th and is in commemoration of the Great Chicago Fire in 1871. Lakewood Firefighters will visit elementary schools during the week to speak to students and demonstrate fire equipment. Our 5th grade students participated in the Junior Fire Chief Essay Contest. Two





students have been selected based on their essays to take the Fire Chief Test. The winners will be announced during the firefighter's visit to Harrison Tuesday, October 10th. All students had the opportunity to participate in a Fire Safety Poster Contest and we look forward to hearing who those winners are as well. The theme this year is "Cooking safety starts with YOU; pay attention to fire prevention".

PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

We are approaching parent/teacher conference time. Conferences are informative and meant to provide parents insight relating to your child's academic progress, expected growth related to grade level standards, strengths, and needs. The schedule provided for conferences is geared to provide some flexibility so that every parent/guardian has an opportunity to participate. VISION OF A LAKEWOOD GRADUATE

We continue to engage our students in learning experiences around The Vision of a Lakewood Graduate Competencies. Our focus for the month of October is *Communication*. Our students will see communication as a means for expressing ideas,



information, feelings, opinions, etc. We will also be learning more about our lens (Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging) by which we view the competencies.

PBIS UPDATE

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a framework for supporting schoolwide practices that teach students appropriate behavior and provide support to sustain the positive behavior. The practices focus on prevention, not punishment. Public schools in Ohio are now required to adopt policies and procedures regarding PBIS.



Harrison has revamped our PBIS Incentive Program. Students earn tickets for demonstrating their understanding of our "Harrison Way to Be" - Be Respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Safe. These tickets can be issued by any staff member. Every Friday, names are drawn during lunch time and those individuals are able to SPIN THE WHEEL OF CHOICES. The prizes include many things such as: snacks, coin for the book vending machine, gadgets, etc. The students are very excited about the program.



PICTURE DAY

Harrison's Picture Day is scheduled for Tuesday, October 24th. We expect to receive the picture order forms this week and we will get them out to families as soon as we receive them. There will also be an option to order photos online as well. Please note that if your child is absent on picture day or there is an issue with regards to the photos you received, there will be a picture retake day. That day has not been scheduled as of yet, but we will inform you once it has been scheduled.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

* Safety Drills are required by the state of Ohio. We will be engaging in Fire Drills, Lockdown Drills, and Tornado Drills throughout the school year.



- * Student Attendance Ohio schools must report student absences as required by House Bill 410. Letters from the district are auto generated and mailed home as students reach the triggered number of hours absent from school. It is important to remember that it is hours not days that are counted. When applicable and possible, we encourage you to obtain a doctor's note so that the absence is noted with documentation. Should there be some ongoing medical condition, please consider reaching out to our health aide so that can be noted as well.
- * Arrival to school & drop off should be a quick process for car riders who are using the curb drop off option. Please prep your child for exiting the car as you wait in line so that students may exit the cars quickly once you approach the drop off area. If you know that your child tends to take a little longer to exit the vehicle, please pull up past the red fire curb area. You are also welcome to park your vehicle in a parking space or in the overflow lot and walk them to the door. This process was established to support parents who are needing to get to work in a timely manner and to make drop off as efficient as possible.
- * Generally every grade level will attend a field trip either on site at the school or outside of the school during the school year. A bus safety session was held for students in grades K-2 should their field trip experience involve a transportation need. This training occurs yearly. We look forward to our students engaging in unique experiences. Please note that your

completion and update of information in Registration Gateway is required for students to attend field trips off school grounds.
