# Expectations/Rules and Procedures.

- Respect and be kind to each other at all times. Respect each other's ideas and property. Encourage a positive learning environment.
- Harassment, Intimidation or Bullying of any kind will be documented and be reported to administration. Verbal warnings are at the teachers discretion: If someone is harassing, intimidating, or bullying you see me privately.
- Keep your hands to yourself: No horseplaying.
- If you are having problems with another student do not take matters into your own hands, see me privately I will help you. Ask for help when needed.
- Be responsible, be on time: If late, a pass is needed or your attendance will be marked tardy after the bell. Be on time in every class.

- Work until the end of the bell: No one is allowed to leave early.
- Have school uniforms on: Insubordinate students will be referred to the vice principal's office.

Administration/security will be notified if the student does not turn in the phone. Phones are not to be charged during class.
