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Fall 2022 Concurrent Enrollment Information

- At GHC, we encourage our high school students to take courses at community colleges to prepare them for future higher education opportunities.
- Students are able to enroll in Pierce classes at the GHC campus for elective courses.
- The Social Justice Pathway Program was introduced in Fall 2021. At this time, there are 25 students enrolled.
- This year we have 100 students concurrently enrolled in community college courses.

Benefits of Concurrent Enrollment Programs

- It provides the opportunity for high school students to take college-level courses.
- Students may explore fields of study that may help them choose a major.
- Students may choose classes not currently offered at GHC.
- Studies have shown that students who participate in dual-enrollment programs are more likely to transfer to complete their 4 year degree.

What is IGETC?

- Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a general education program that California Community College transfer students can use to fulfill lower-division general education requirements at a UC/CSU campus.
- The advantages of completing IGETC include more flexibility in class selection at the university and timely progress toward degree completion.

Using IGETC

- IGETC is not an admission requirement for the UC/CSU application.
- All UC/CSU campuses will accept the completed IGETC to satisfy all lower division general education requirements.

*Individual colleges or majors within a UC/CSU campus may not accept IGETC for general education.

• The IGETC plan totals 34-47 transferable semester units.

Pierce College Course Information



The courses offered will be asynchronous. It is recommended students take science and math courses in-person.

2 Students will complete 2-3 courses each semester.



Upon completion of the IGETC courses, students will be eligible to receive an IGETC Associates of Arts degree and participate in the Pierce College commencement ceremony.
