THE GIFT OF PARENTING A PRESCHOOLER

Transitions: Code Red Incoming! (But Not Really)

Let's be honest—transitions are tough for everyone. But for preschoolers? They can feel like full-blown emergencies. Imagine being told to stop playing with your favorite toy just to brush your teeth or get ready for bed. Not fun, right? For little kids, switching from something they love to something less exciting can lead to major meltdowns. And it's not because they're being difficult-they're still learning how to handle big feelings.

So, what helps? The setup is everything. Try giving your child a few friendly reminders that a change is coming. You can also use a timer (bonus: kids love pushing the button!). This gives them a heads-up that one activity is ending and another is about to begin.

Pro tip: Build in a little extra time during your day just for transitions. It gives everyone some breathing room and keeps things calmer. Creating mini routines around transitions can work wonders too. For example, have a "parking spot" at the dinner table where your child can "park" their toy car while they eat-fun, and it helps them feel a little more in control.

Above all, meet these moments with patience and empathy. With a little prep (and a lot of love), even the trickiest transitions can go more smoothly.
