Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this message finds you well. We would like to inform you that due to the Met Office Amber weather warning predicting torrential rain and strong winds with gusts of over 60mph caused by Storm Ciaran, The Hastings Academy will be opening at a later time of 10:00 am tomorrow, 2nd November.

This decision has been made to ensure the safety of our students and staff, allowing them additional time to make their way to the school site, considering the potential transport issues that may arise due to the adverse weather conditions.
