A Community of Collaboration

At Nazareth Academy, we believe that every student can learn, grow and achieve academic excellence. Immersed in an atmosphere of high academic standards, we challenge each student to discover and reach beyond her full potential. Varied curriculum inspires constant creativity from our students in all subject areas, and students are given diverse opportunities for achievement both within and outside of the traditional classroom. Qualities such as integrity, respect, love and acceptance permeate the students' educational experiences.

Nazareth students look to one another to collaborate. Collaboration requires trust, respect, and clear communication – all traits and skills that are ingrained within the rigorous curriculum and teachings at Nazareth Academy. However, cultivating collaboration also requires the physical space where students can seamlessly work together and share ideas.

In partnership with the Ambassador's Fund for Catholic Education, the Nazareth Academy library was repurposed to a multimedia center. New collaborative tables with built-in charging stations were added to the modernized space. This renovation marked the second phase of our STREAM (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Art, Math) initiative. Students directly benefited from the transformation as they spent this past year studying and working



with one another during Activity Period on projects. The multimedia center now serves as a space for club meetings, group projects, and research encouraging collaboration and inspiring innovation amongst students.

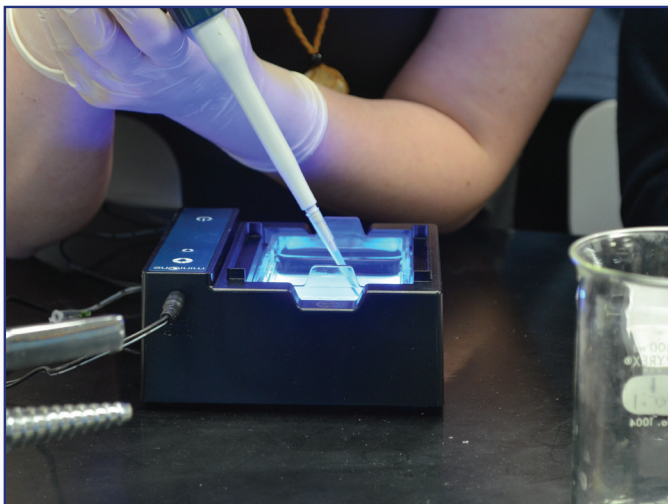

In the spring semester, students directly benefited from another generous contribution from our Nazareth community. Thanks to Nazareth family and friends in memory of Dr. Mary Ellen Juliano Terrels '74, the Nazareth biology lab was gifted state-of-the-art lab equipment.

“Over the course of the semester, we were able to do four labs with our new lab equipment that further enhanced our students' learning and understanding of DNA. The culmination of the lab allowed our students to take their own DNA and test to see whether or not they had a genetic marker for tasting bitterness. The students loved our lab days and showed a greater understanding of the material from the opportunity of doing these

hands-on labs. I am so appreciative of this generous donation which has allowed our students to take their learning to the next level.”

Throughout this hands-on experience, students worked in groups as they completed the four-part experiment. Using cutting-edge tools such as micropipettes and centrifuges, students collected and analyzed complex data in each lab.

The Strength of the Sisterhood

Collaboration is woven throughout the Nazareth Academy High school community. This past year, collaboration displayed itself in many ways. Whether it was our basketball and swimming teams as they competed in state championship games, our performers as they took their final bow in the fall musical, or our 21 students who achieved AP scholar recognition – Nazareth Academy is a community that joins together to celebrate, motivate, and support one another.

In the last year, particularly, Nazareth Academy High School alumnae exhibited the remarkable power of how joining forces and strength in numbers can truly make a difference. It began with a simple Facebook message from Sara Campagna Martin '93 to her classmates and resulted in \$16,000 raised to support future Pandas.

"I started a conversation on our class Facebook page to gauge interest in supporting our alma mater by sponsoring a scholarship at Nazareth. I was truly excited when I saw so many "YES"



responses. As a result, I worked with Nazareth to establish a framework for the Class of 1993 Scholarship. The scholarship would be awarded to an incoming freshman for her 4 years at Nazareth, certainly helping to make a Nazareth education more affordable for her family."

In a few short months, she and her classmates surpassed their initial \$5,000 goal. Two generous members of the Class of 1993 then decided to match the initial goal of \$5,000, bringing the total amount raised to \$16,000. These funds were divided into two four-year scholarships awarded to two members of the Class of 2027. The two future Pandas would receive \$2,000 per year for their four years at Nazareth Academy High School.

“The reason the scholarship was so successful was because of the smaller gifts each one of us donated. There is power in numbers, and it is amazing what collective generosity can do. It is our responsibility, as Nazareth Academy alumnae, to make sure Nazareth continues to thrive.”

Sara's actions rippled throughout the alumnae community, inspiring others to spearhead their own class scholarships. Blair Holubec Sullivan '03 led her classmates as they raised \$4,000 for a member of the class of 2027 to be distributed over the course of her four years at Nazareth. Following in the footsteps of the classes of 1993 and 2003, Judy Rynkiewicz Zdunkiewicz '86 began rallying



her classmates, and they are currently on their way to raising \$4,000 for the Class of 1986 Scholarship to be awarded to a member of the class of 2028.

These class scholarships are a testament to the strength of the Nazareth Academy sisterhood.

As students leave Nazareth prepared for college and beyond, they are also leaving with a network of talented, driven and generous alumnae – a sisterhood that truly lasts a lifetime. It is within the moments of collaboration and coming together to uplift future generations of Nazareth students that the sisterhood shines. It is true that blue and gold are far better together than apart. ♦
