

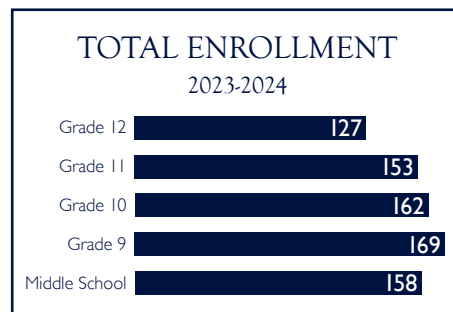


THE URSULINE SCHOOL 2023-24 PROFILE

Founded in 1897, The Ursuline School is a Catholic college preparatory school for girls and young women, grades 6-12. The Ursuline School is one of a network of secondary schools and colleges of the Ursuline Sisters across the United States and 36 countries. The school is accredited by the National Association of Independent Schools, NY State Board of Regents, and is a member of the National Coalition of Girls Schools and NY State Association of Independent Schools. The campus is located 20 miles north of Manhattan in a diverse, suburban community.

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

A minimum of 24 credits are required for graduation, including:

- 4 credits each of: English, Social Studies
- 3 credits each of: Math, Science, World / Classical Language (the third level of a language must be attained)
- 2.5 credits of: Religious Studies
- 1 credit each of: Fine Art/Music, Physical Education
- .5 credit of Computer Science

- The GPA is computed on a 4.0 point scale.
- A cumulative weighted GPA appears on the transcript as well as each academic year GPA
- College preparatory: 1.4 weight, Accelerated: 1.5 weight, Honors: 1.6 weight, or AP: 1.8 weight, courses are offered.
- The Ursuline School does not provide class rank.

- Students enrolled in an AP course are required to take the AP exam. Enrollment in AP courses is subject to departmental approval and is reserved primarily for juniors & seniors. Students are not advised to enroll in more than 3 AP courses during any given year.
 - In 2023, 89% of examinees scored a 3 or higher
- Of the Class of 2024, 80% will graduate with enrollment in at least one AP level course
- Mean number of AP courses through four years: 4

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS:

Advantage Program: Select courses are available to earn college credit via St. John's University.

Global Scholars: As part of the Ursuline Education Network (UEN), a designation is offered to seniors completing a curriculum with global focus and demonstrating a commitment to global citizenship, empathy, and advocacy/service. In their senior year, candidates present an independent, academic research project focused on a global issue of concern.

Science Research: A selective three-year sequence of additional science courses focusing on hypothesis development, application of the research process and work with a mentor from the scientific community. Culminates in a formal research paper and presentation.

Reading and Language Development: Qualified students receive academic support and strategies from learning specialists to complement classroom instruction and aid in testing.

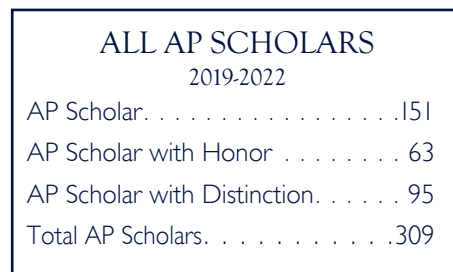
