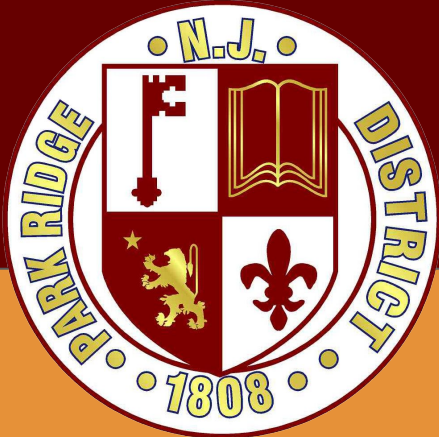

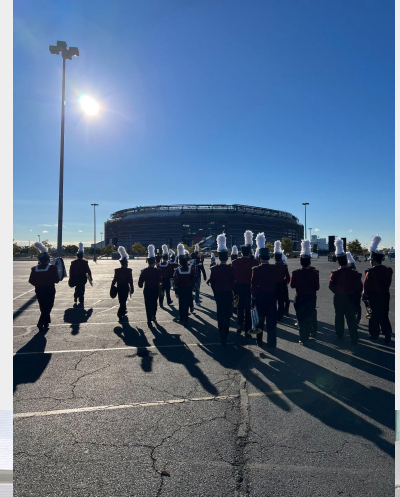
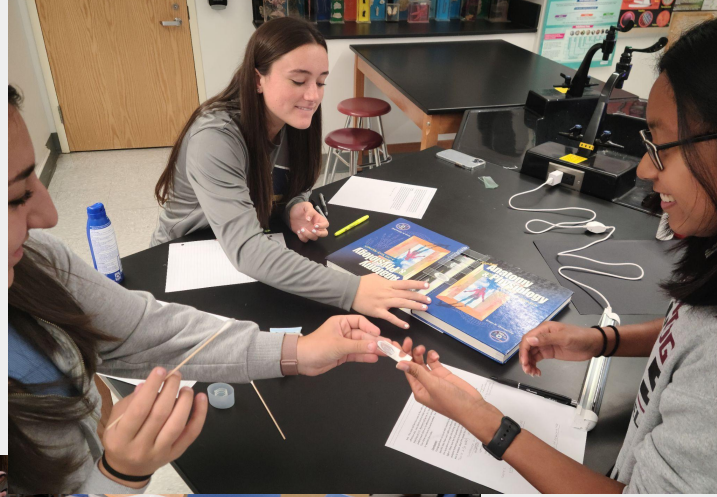

NJSLA Overview

- The NJSLA was first administered in 2019
- Replaced the PARCC exam
- Not administered in 2020 or 2021 due to COVID closures - trend analysis requires 3 years of consecutive data in the same test
- Students take NJSLA in the following grades/subjects:
 - ELA in grades 3-9
 - Math in grades 3-8, and also Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry
 - Science in grades 5, 8, and 11
- Statewide testing takes 180 minutes for ELA (150 for Grade 3), 180 minutes for Math, and 180 minutes for Science (240 minutes for Grade 11)

NJGPA Overview

- The NJGPA was first administered in 2022
- Utilizes the same online test-delivery system as the NJSLA
- Originally designed to be the primary pathway for graduation for class of 2022
 - Designated by law, now, as a field test
 - Still scheduled to be the primary pathway for class of 2023 and going forward
- Students take NJGPA in the following grades/subjects:
 - ELA and Math in grade 11
- Test length was 180 minutes for each subject

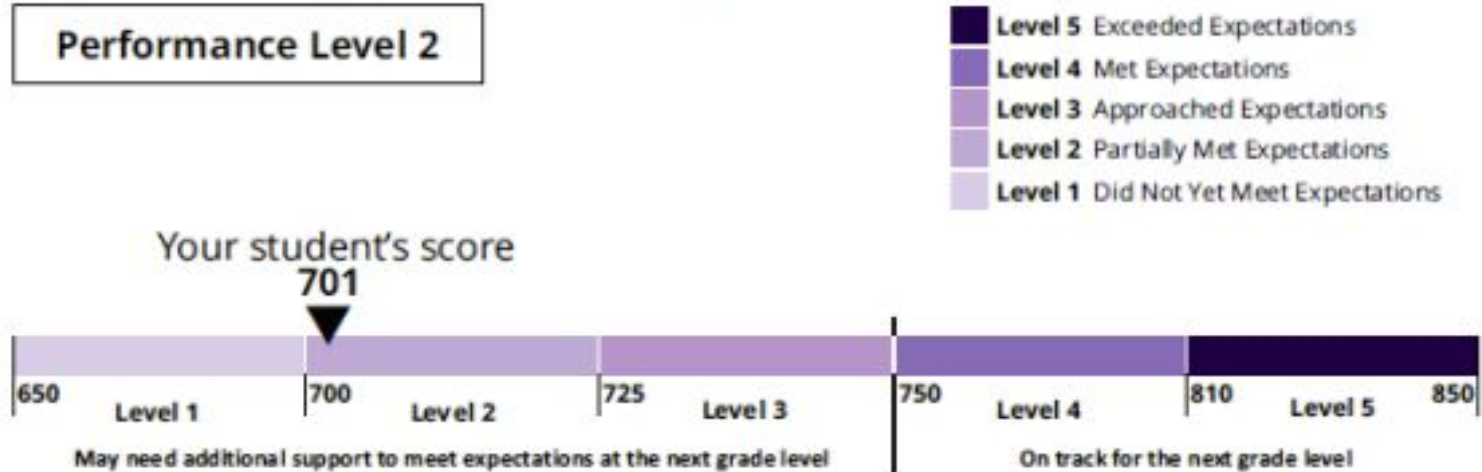

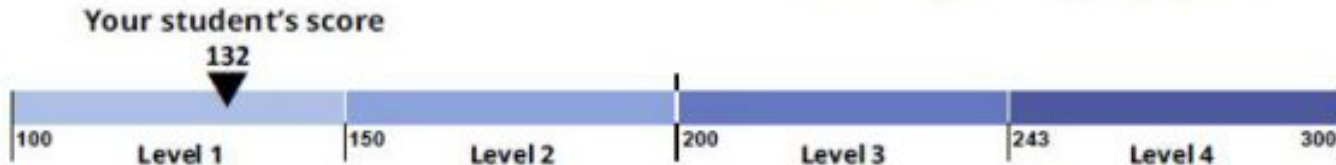

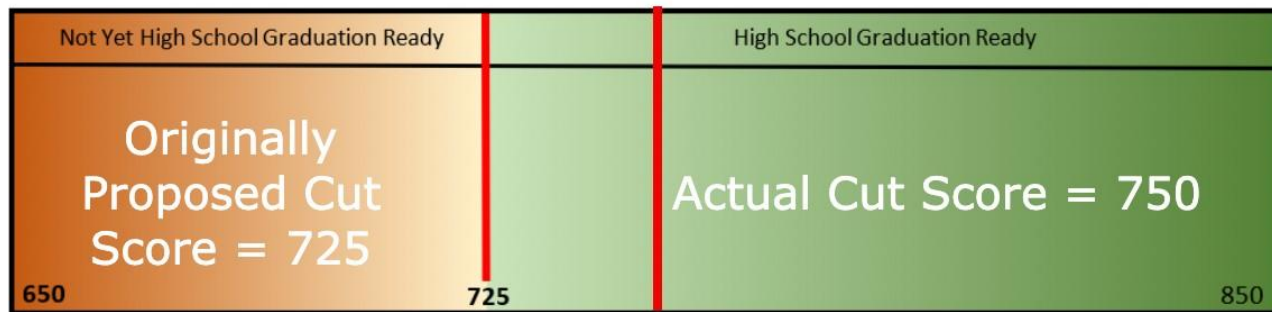
FIRSTNAME001's score on the NJSLA-S indicates that your student is at Level 1.

Students who are at Level 1 demonstrated a minimal understanding of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards-Science (NJSLS-S) by misinterpreting information from a variety of sources (e.g., text, charts, graphs, tables) and inconsistently applying the knowledge gained from scientific investigations to develop incorrect explanations or models of observed phenomena. The students had difficulty choosing and using, even with significant scaffolding, the appropriate tools to make observations and to gather, classify, and present data. The students struggled to use essential information to recognize patterns and relationships between data and designed systems. The students seldom used information to make real-world connections or predictions.

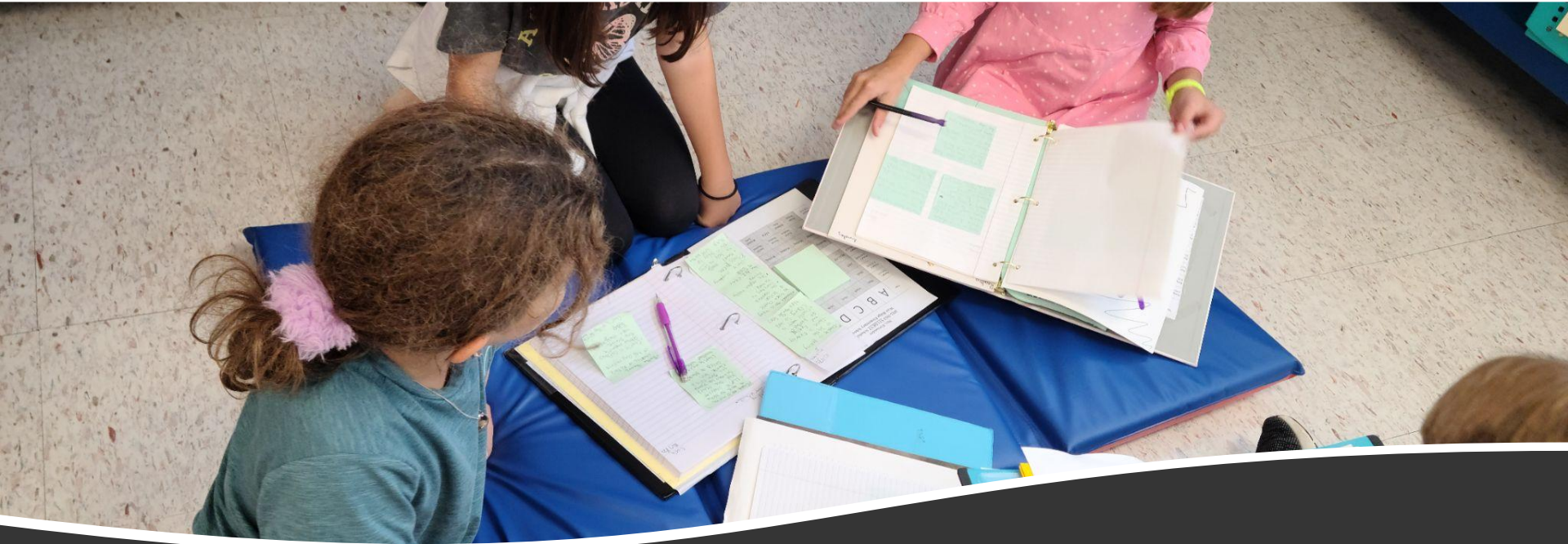
Note: NJGPA has a hard cut score, which designates students as either 'Graduation Ready' or 'Not Graduation Ready.'

NJSLA Scale

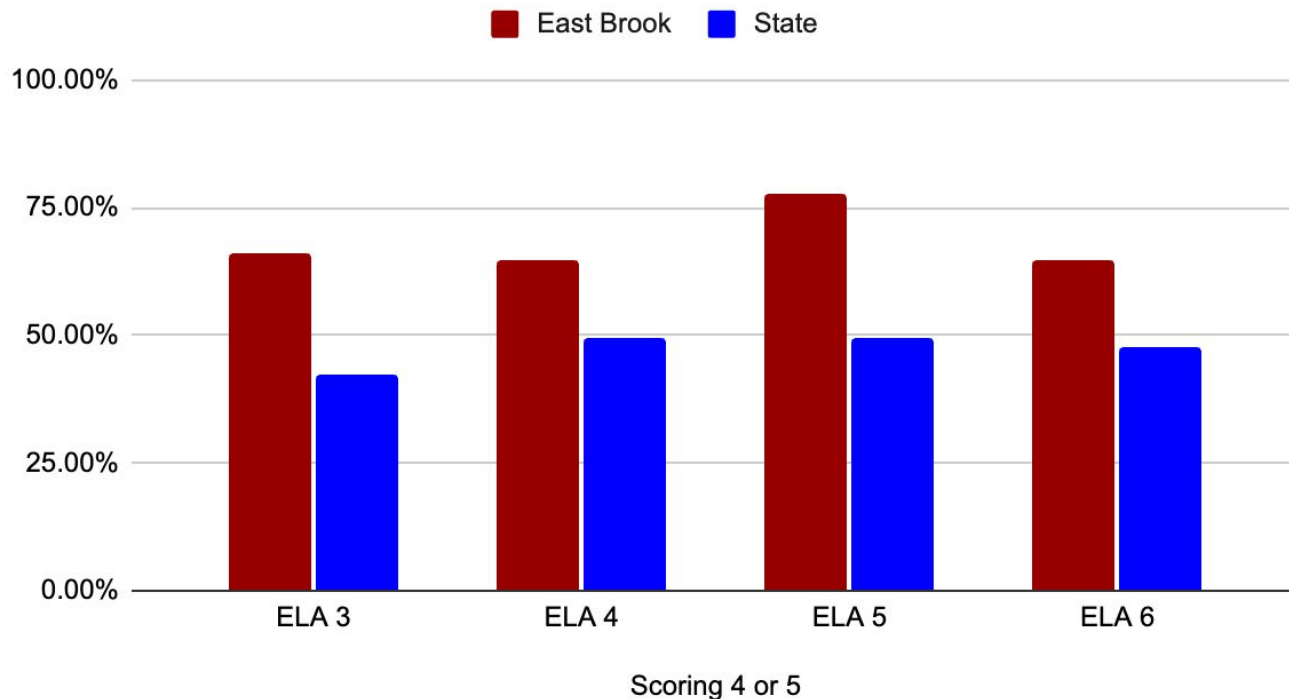




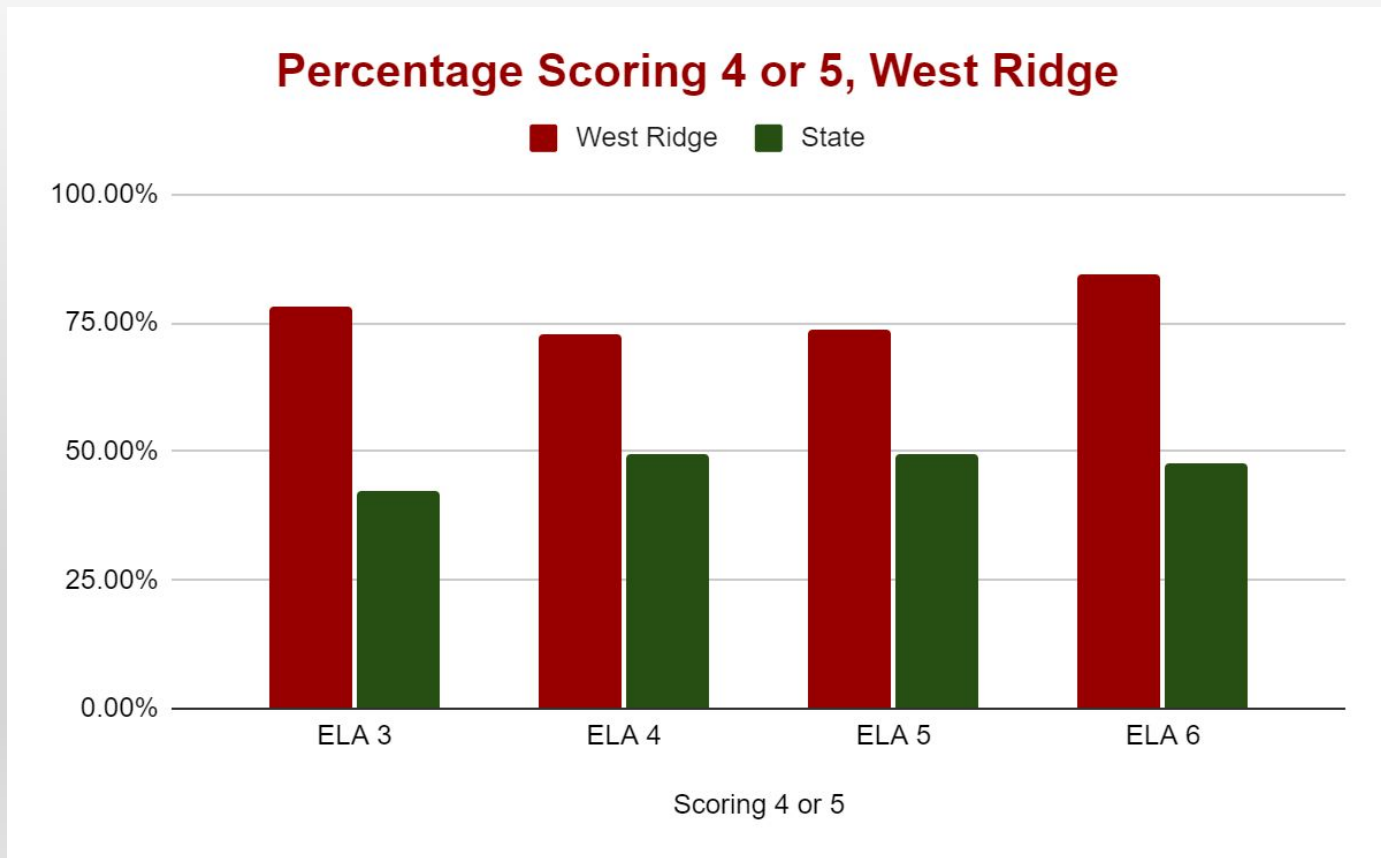

East Brook Results - ELA

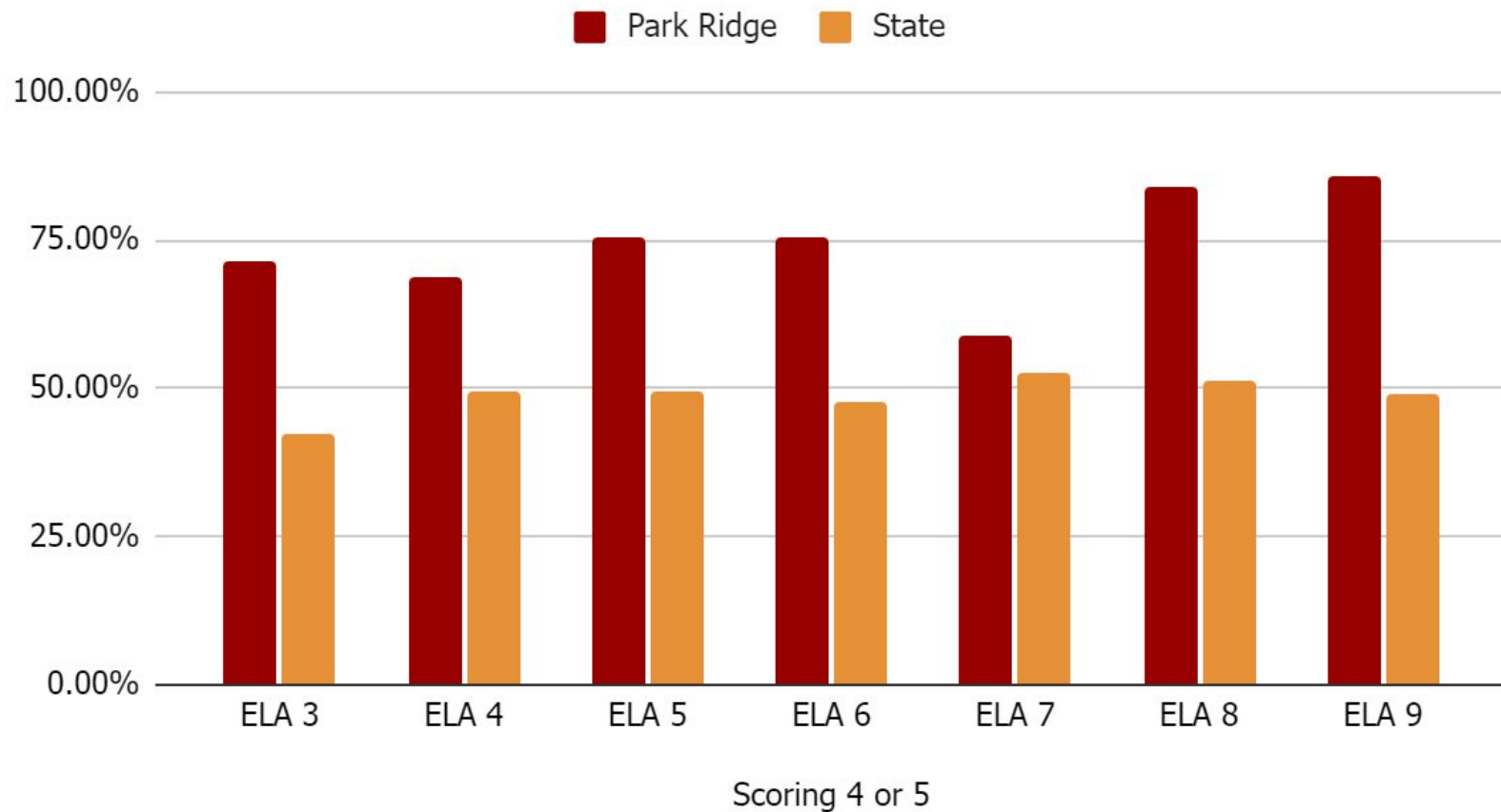
Percentage Scoring 4 or 5, East Brook



West Ridge Results - ELA



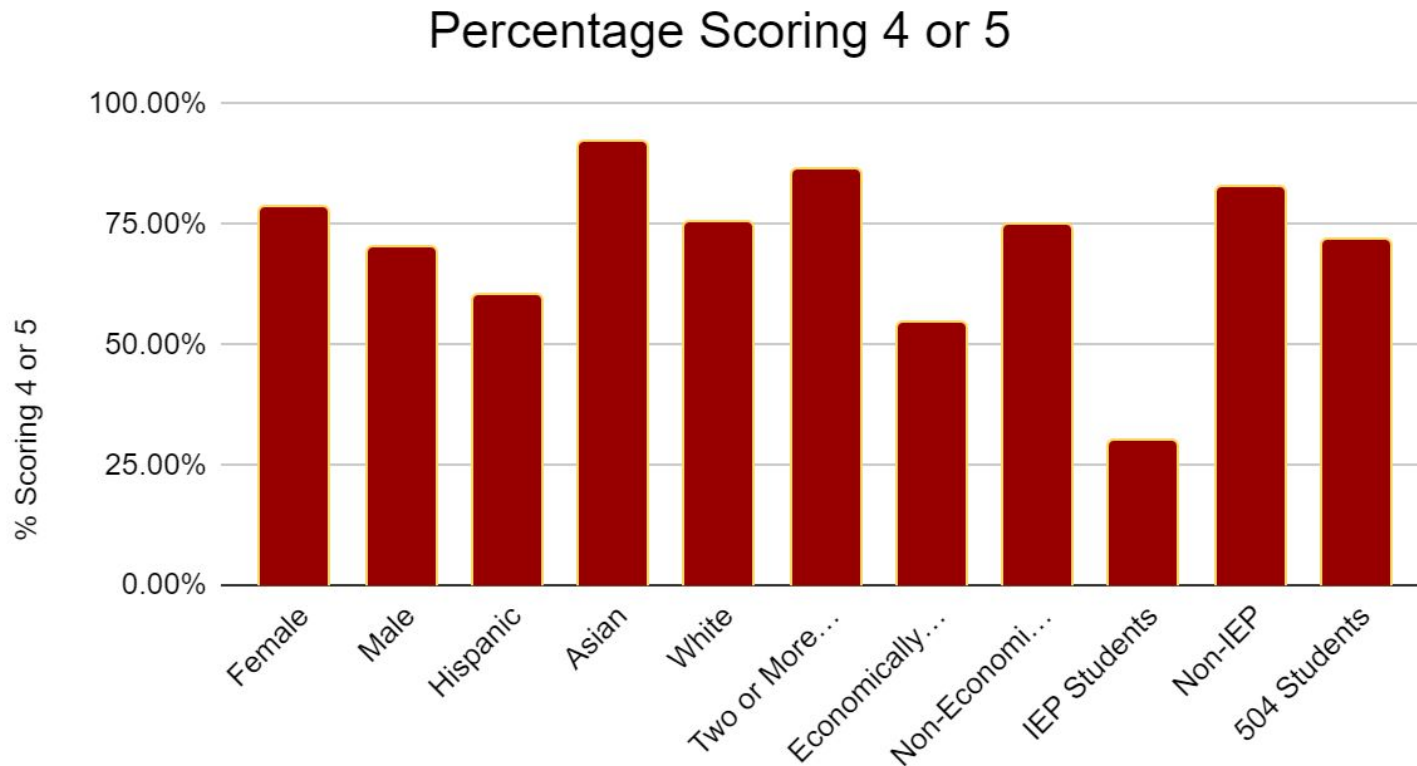
% Students Met or Exceeded, PRSD and State

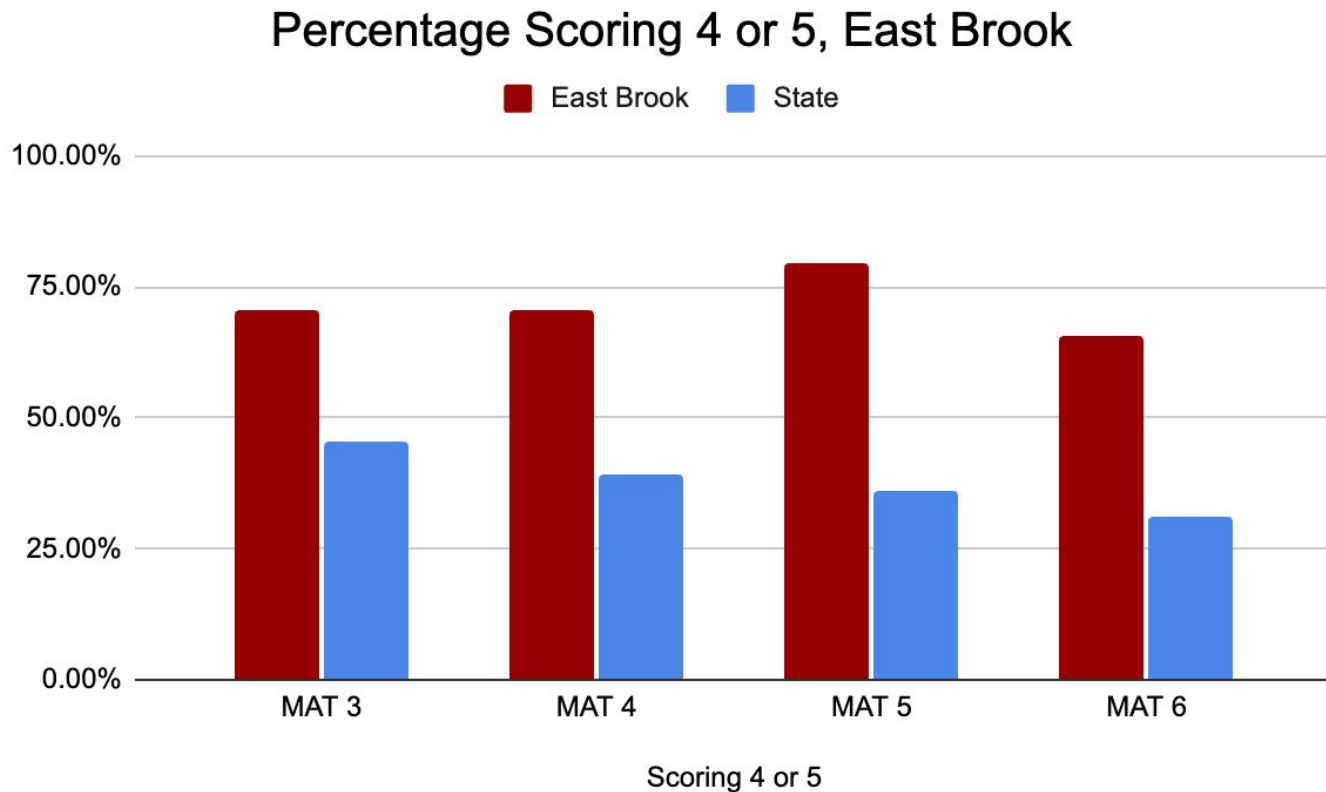

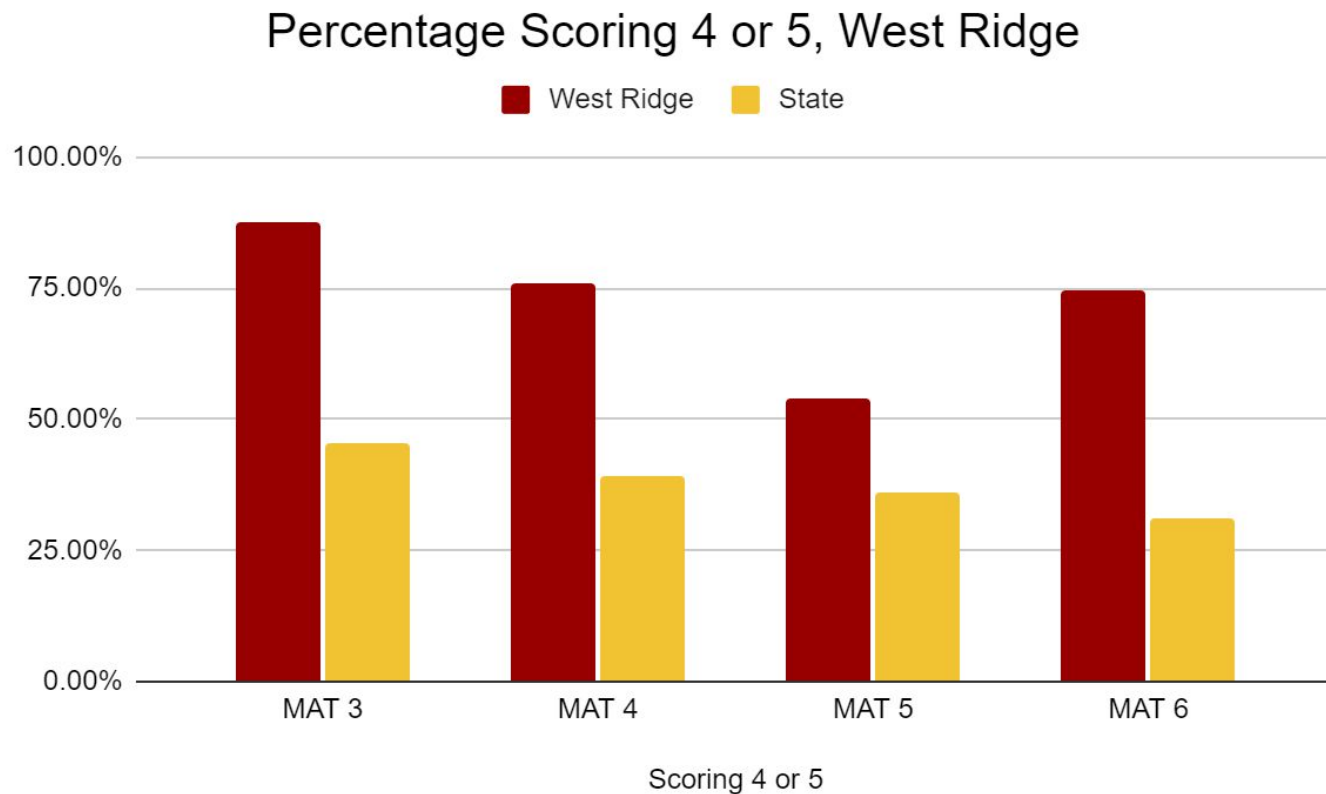

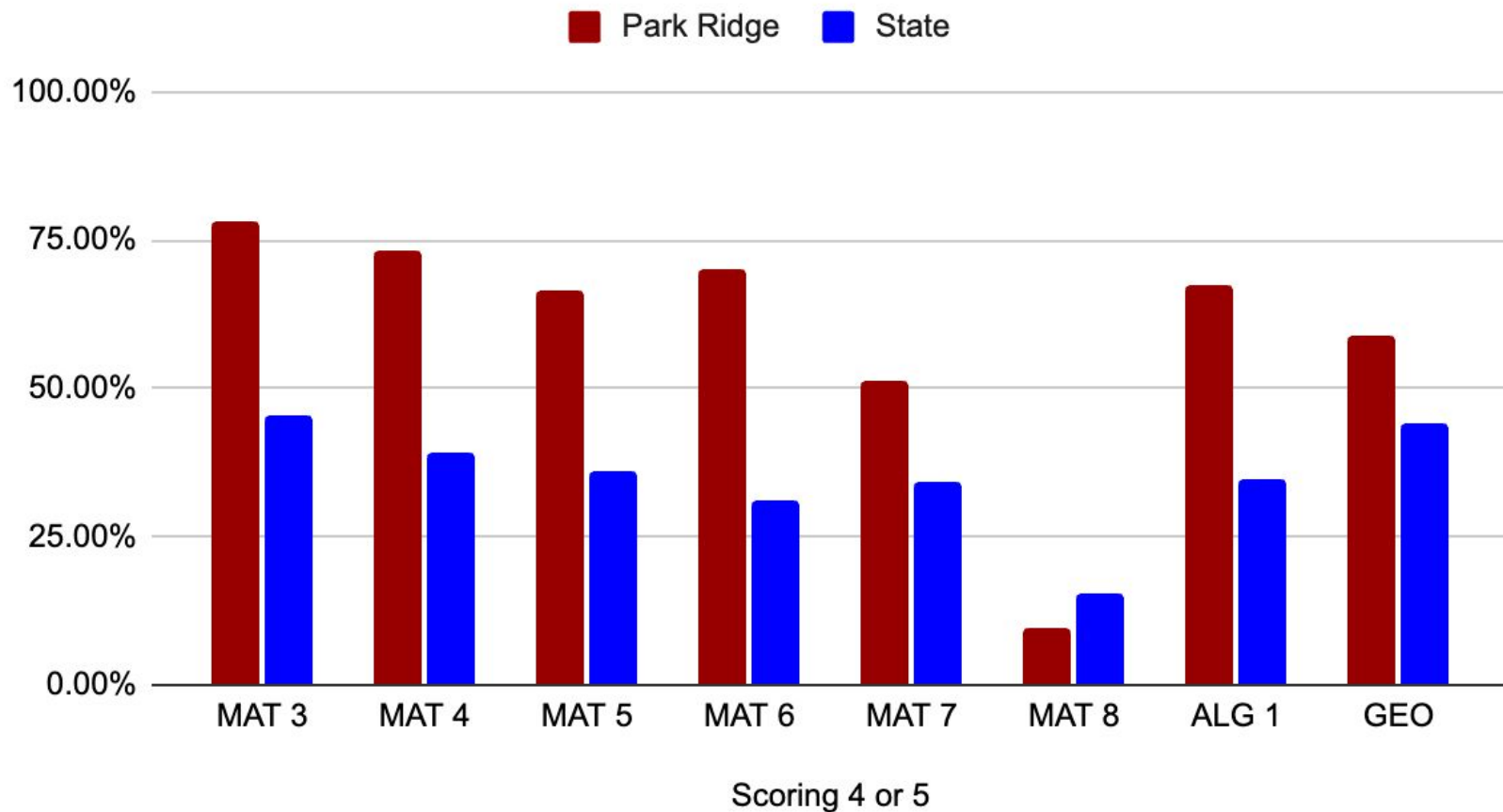
East Brook Results - Math



West Ridge Results - Math



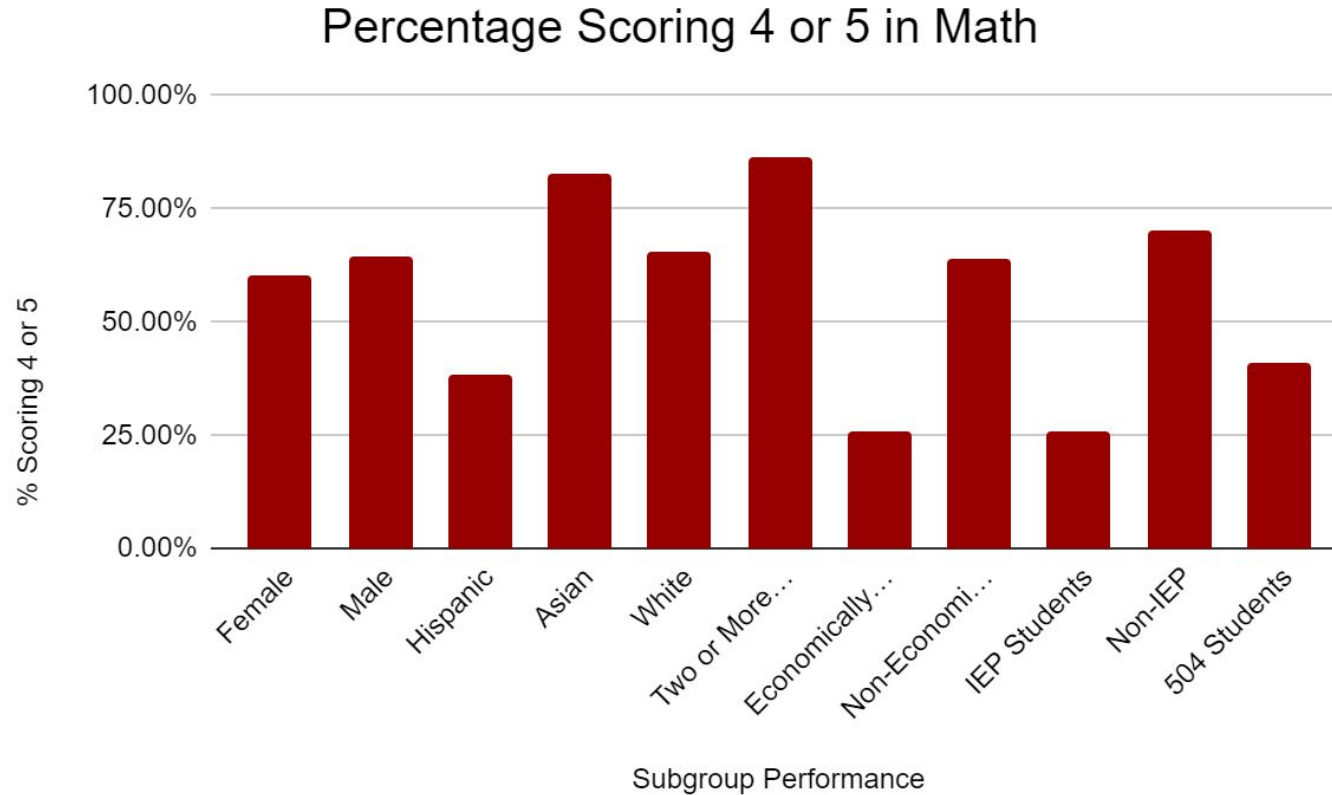

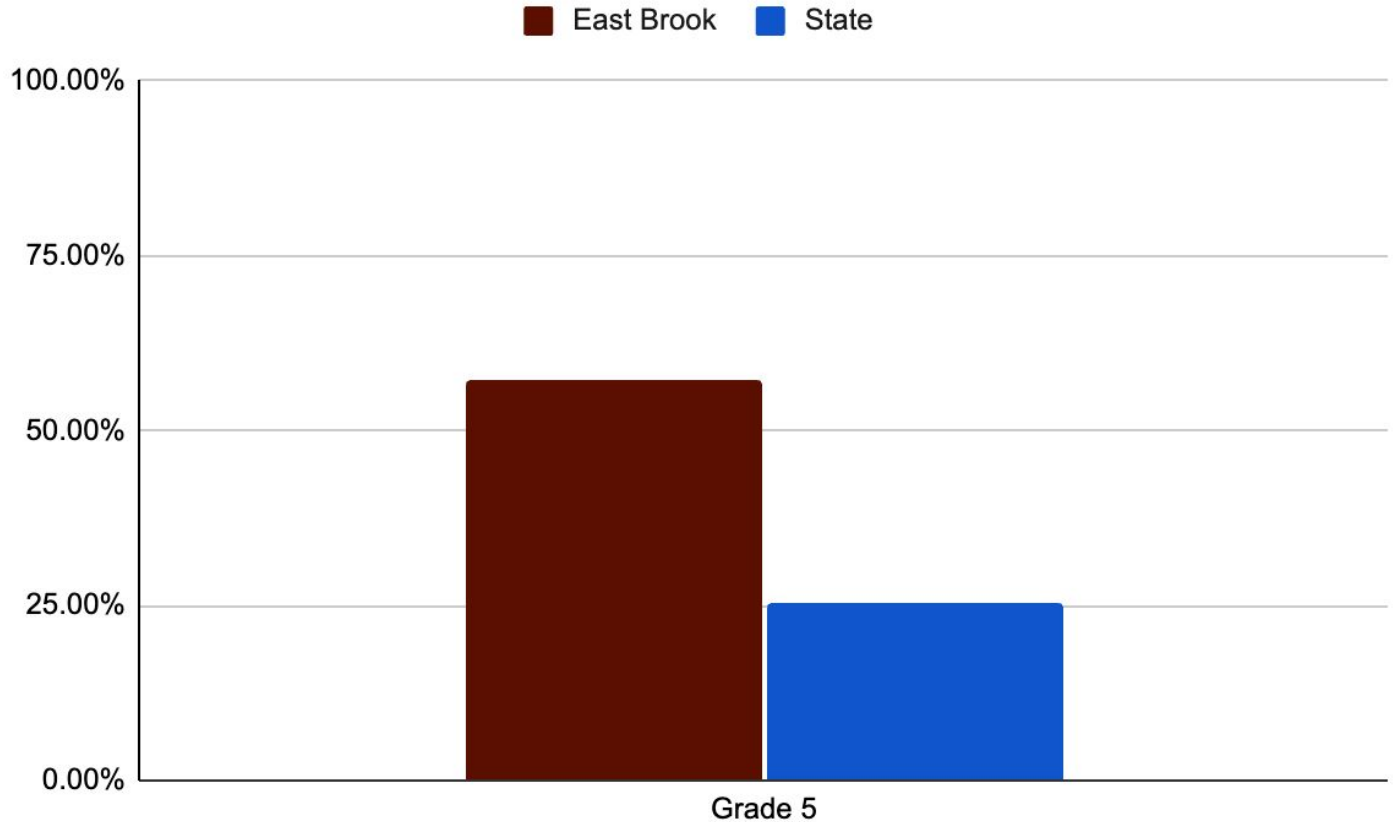

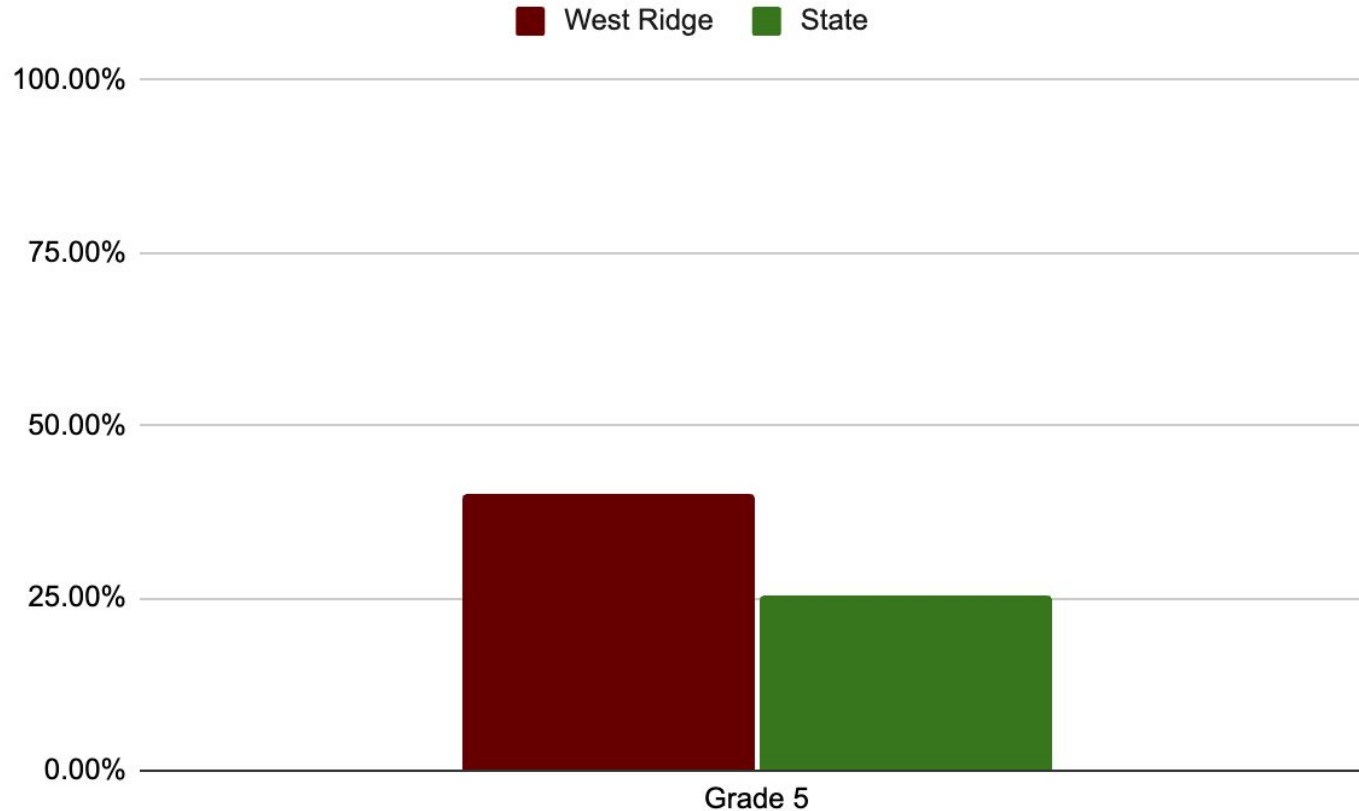
East Brook Results - Science

(Percentage scoring Proficient or higher)



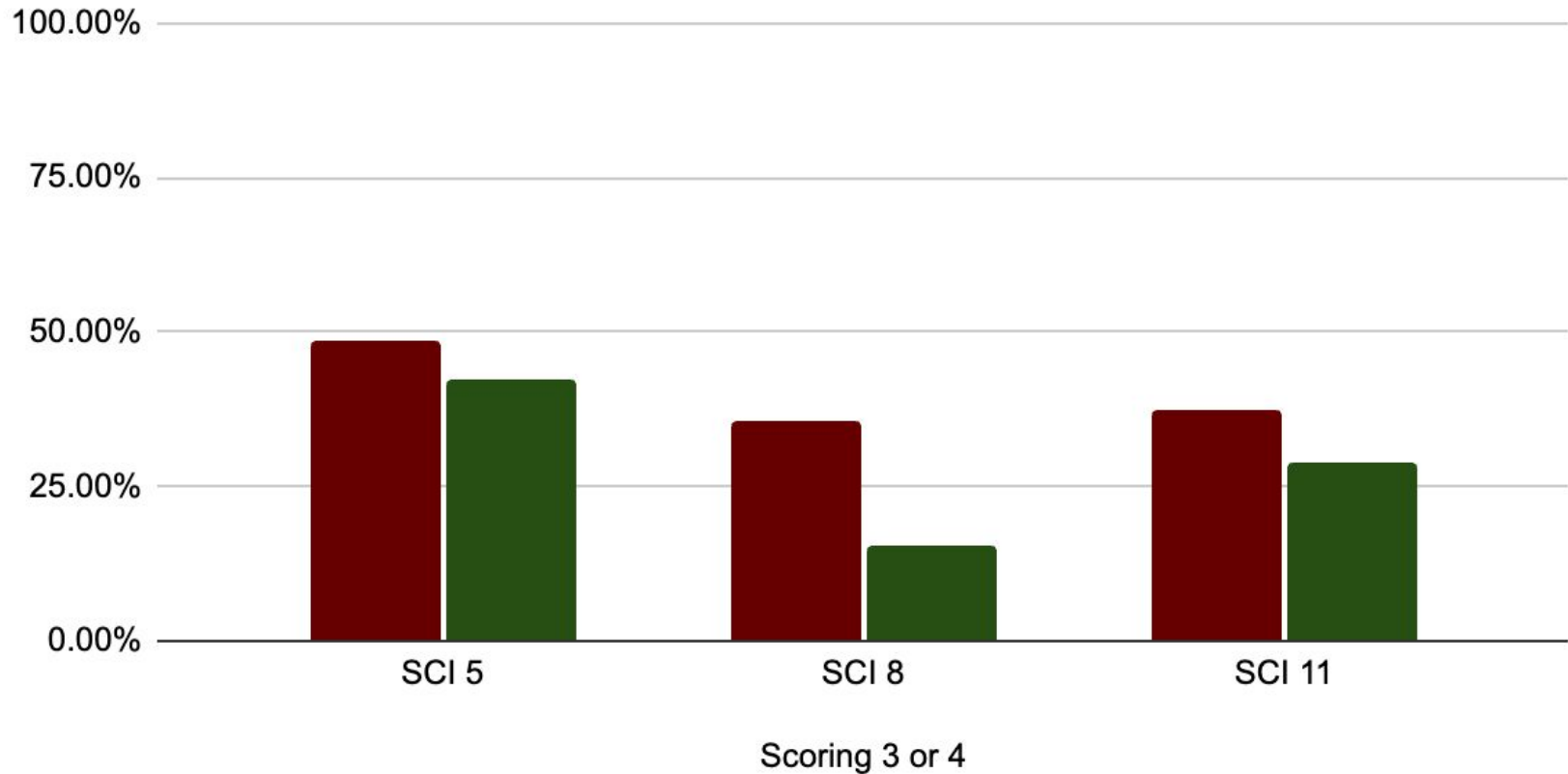
West Ridge Results - Science

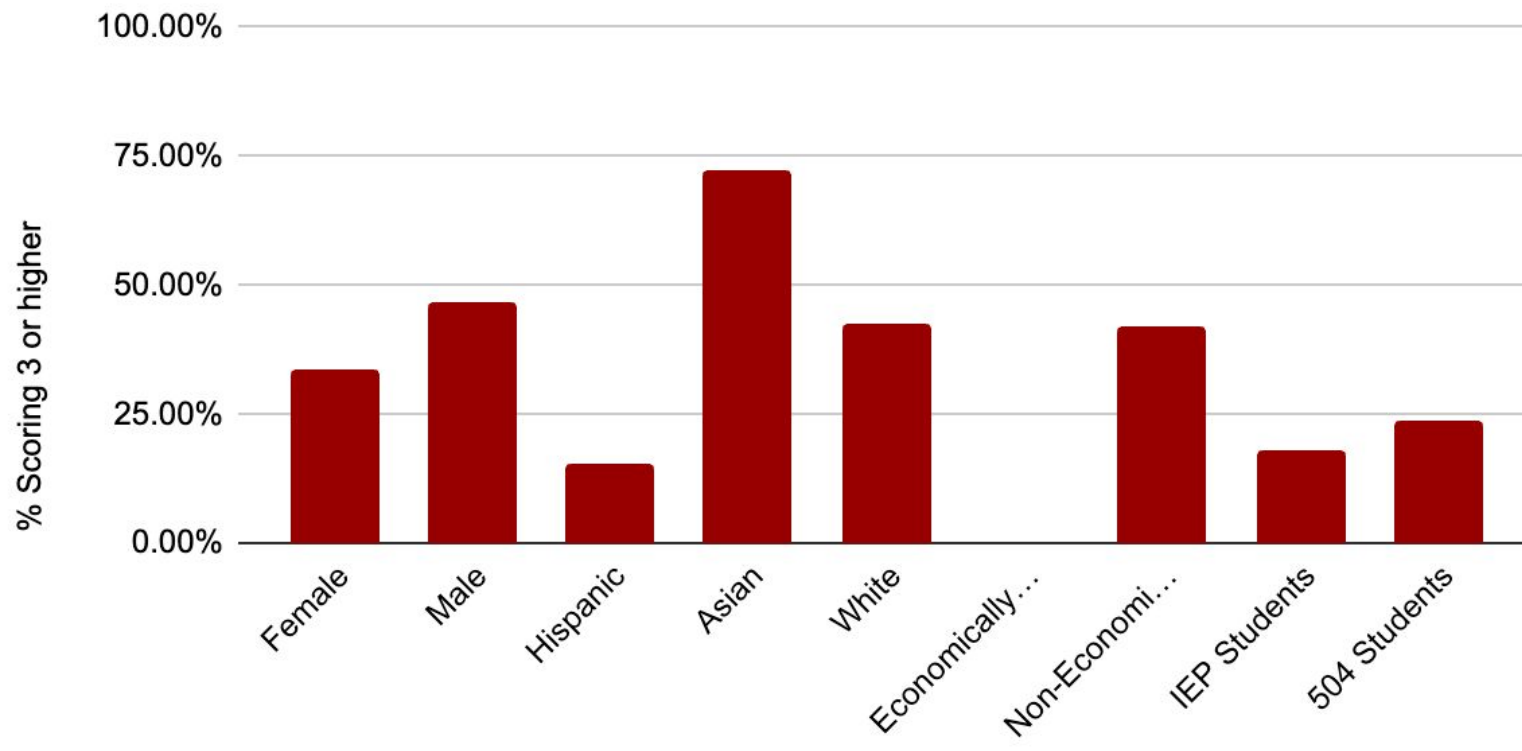

Percentage Scoring 3 or Higher

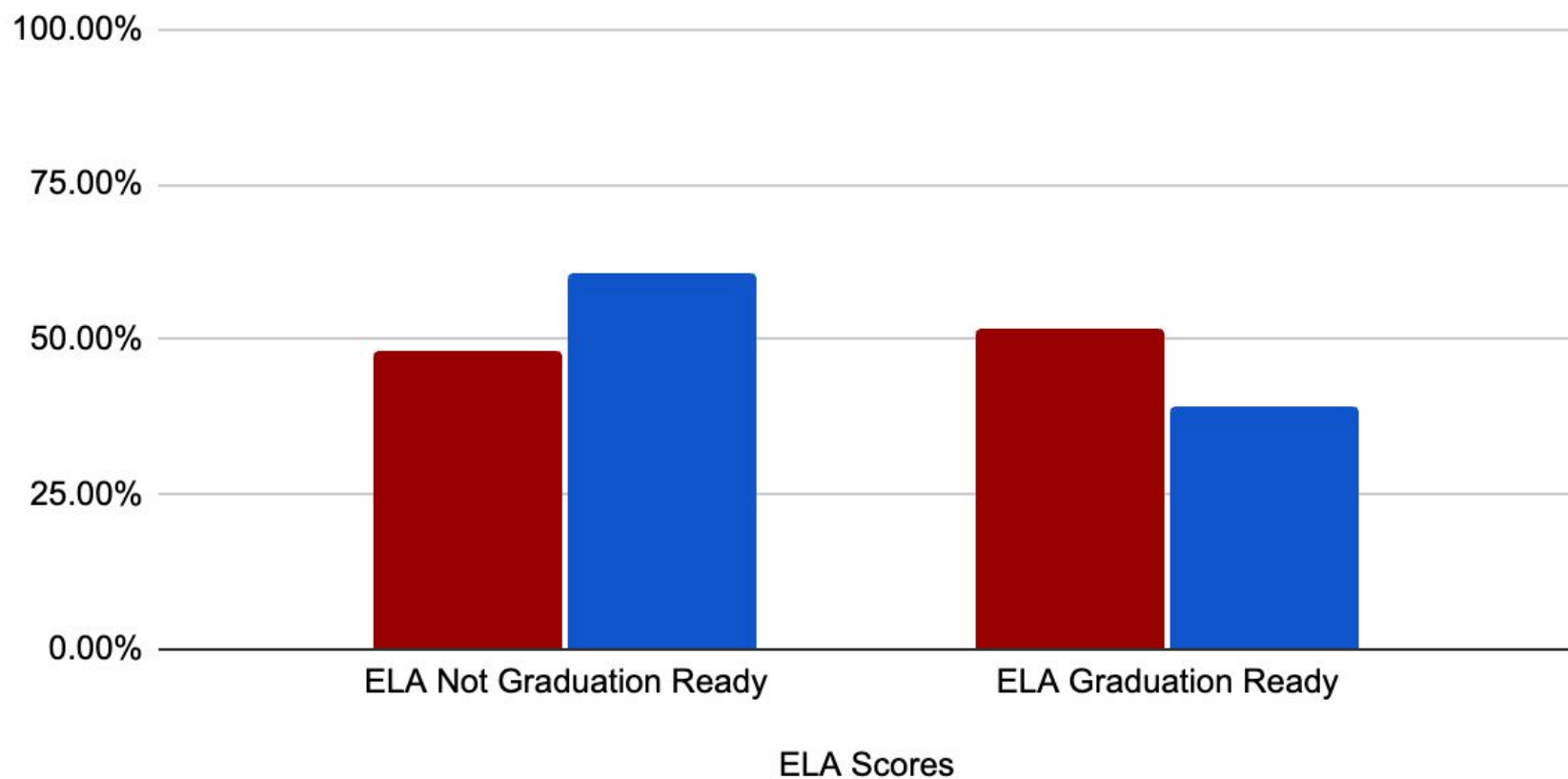

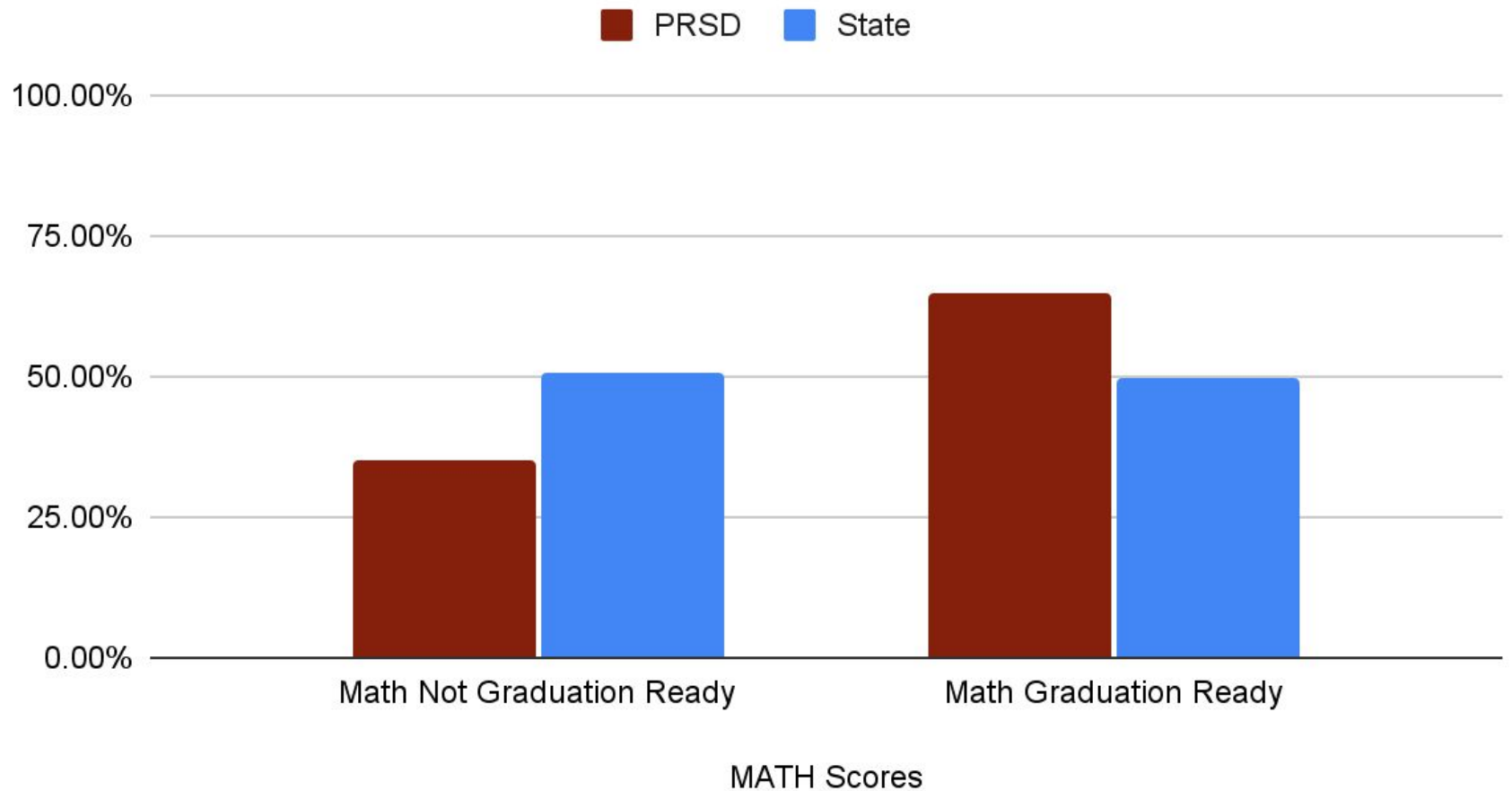

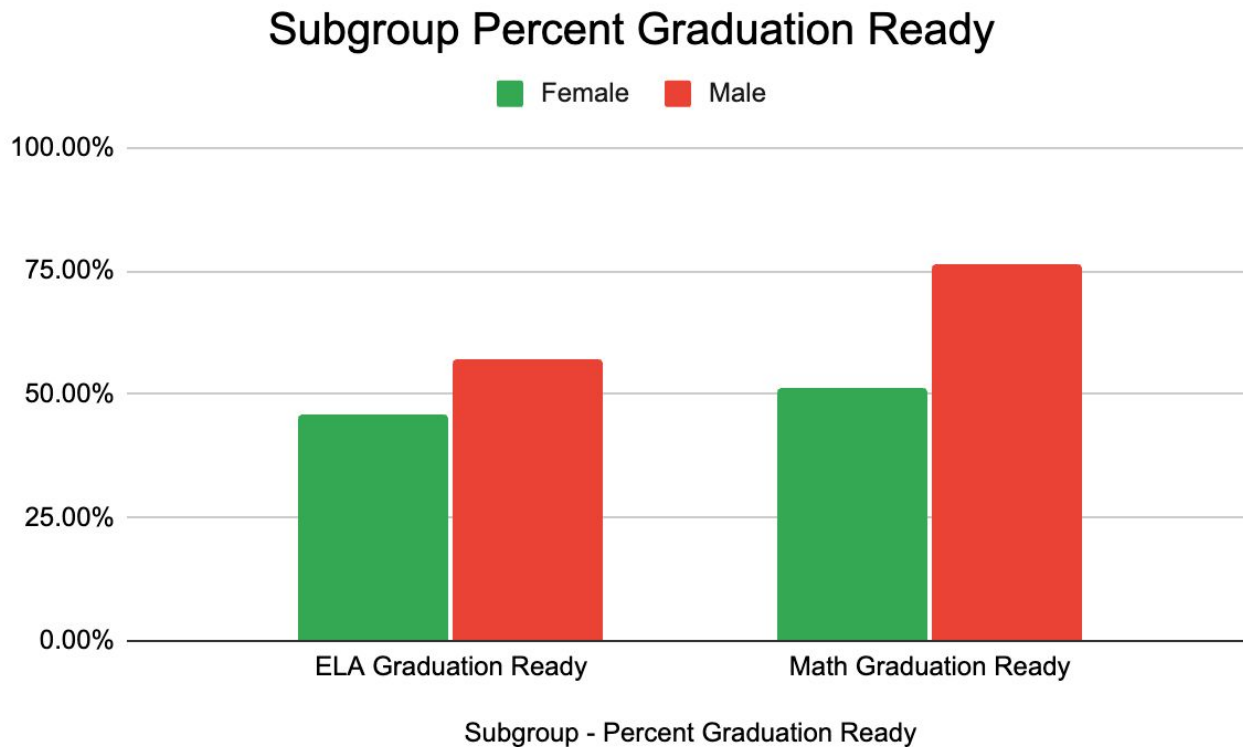

Park Ridge Initiatives – Data Analysis

- Met in departments, grade-levels, and disciplines to review data from NJSLA and Start Strong (2022 scores not yet published)
- Teachers have looked at data including question-type analysis (where can we improve?)
- Data investigation includes related departments and teachers - so at the high school, our business teachers joined the math discussion, and our Social Studies teachers looked at ELA results
- Meeting time includes after-school meetings, as well as P.D. days
- At elementary schools, the BSI teachers used these results as part of their criteria for entry into Basic Skills

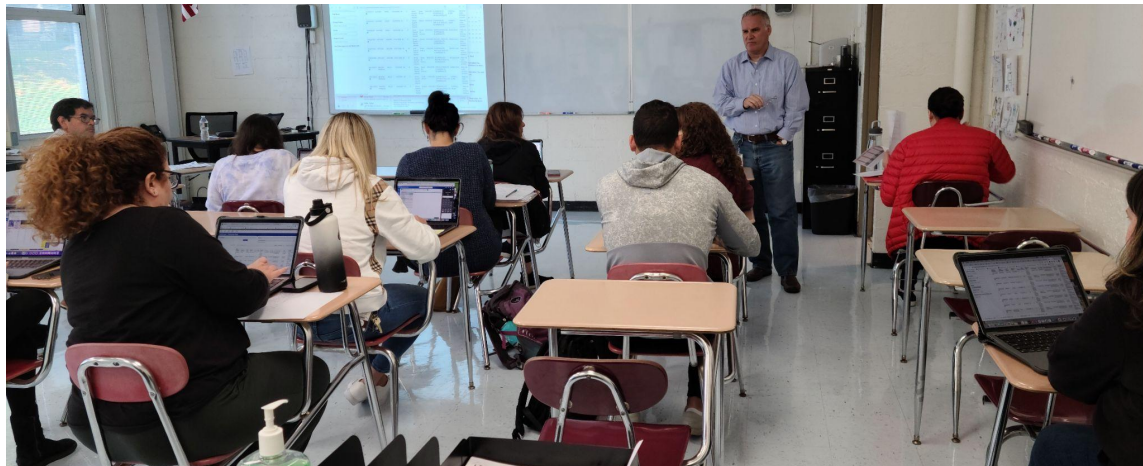
- Hired new teachers/positions for BSI and Special Education at West Ridge, East Brook, and PRHS

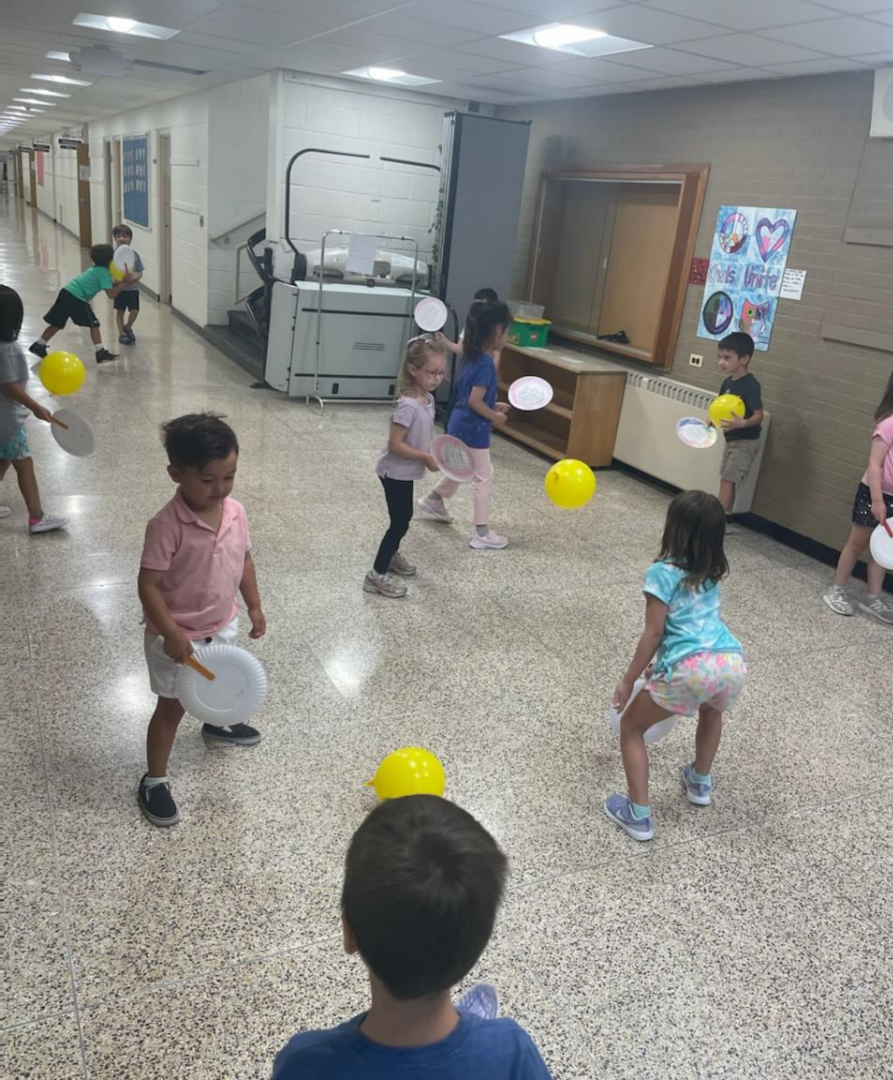

Park Ridge Initiatives - Extending the School Day/ Summer Activities

- Summer Owl Academy ran for the second straight year
- Hoot Camp returned this year
- Expanded extra-help program at elementary schools
- Implemented 7th Grade Orientation week at high school
- Implemented online Evening Office Hours at high school

Park Ridge Initiatives – Teacher PD and Grant Funding

Some highlights:

- Our teachers have taken advantage of many PD opportunities
- Utilized grant money for extending PD opportunities
- Classes through the Northern Valley Curriculum Center
- Partnership with The Madison Institute to provide high-quality PD in SEL, Reading, and Instructional Design
- TMI provided PD on formative assessments
- At the elementary school, we have continued to work on developing facility with Fountas and Pinnell, and have expanded our usage of the program
- Rolling out a new phonics program, K-2
