- Discuss Holmes Strategic Purpose plan
  - Holmes stakeholders (4 parents, leadership, teachers, Brandon Comfort , Nicole Ottmer) meet for a few days and discussed strategic purpose for Holmes. Only west side middle only school. What do we want for Holmes, what do we need to stop/change here, how to stop strategic abandonment.
  - Drilled into 5 E data and then what is our vision for Holmes going forward.
  - How do we accomplish a vertical academic master plan with our 5 feeder schools. Bristol (stem) Holbert (outside education) Trailblazer (placed based experience), Chipeta, Jackson
  - Focus Areas
    - Authentic Learning
    - Supportive Environment
    - Proactive, Collaborative Community

The strategy drives the One Plan – bring this work to the One Plan symposium June 1 and 2

  - Major improvement strategies for enrollment, attendance, etc
  - Social media blitz in June, July, Aug again in Dec, Jan, Feb
- Review/discuss instructional focus and "One Plan" USIP goals for next year.
  - Major Improvement Strategies – where are they effective?
    - Best first instructions/building relations and engagement with cooperative
      - Learning owned classroom environment, breaking up the 6 phases of learning in stages – should have increased growth and achievement results. STAR results show Median Growth wanted to hit 45 in math we hit a 46 , ELA 50 we had a 52. SAC recommends we stay the course as improvements are happening.
      - Continue 6 phases and authentic learning.
    - Behavior One Plan Goals – decreasing the # of behavior incidents, we reduced by half which was our target. Next year want to reduce this year’s number by half again. Will do some strategic planning and communication on behavior policies for next school year.
    - Trauma responsive classrooms, PBIS rewards (consistency) showed to be successful.
