



INTRODUCTION

Millfield School was founded in 1935, starting with just six Indian Princes, and is a member of the prestigious Headmasters and Headmistresses Conference (HMC). The School is one of the UK's largest independent, co-educational boarding and day, five-year secondary (high) schools, enrolling 1330 students across Years 9 -13 (equivalent to Grades 8-12 in the US High School system). Millfield has been named the UK's Co-Educational Independent School of the Year.

Millfield is not like other traditional UK independent schools, it believes in shaping the school around the student, where excellence in teaching and coaching comes together with the child at the centre so that each individual can discover their own brilliance. Each year Millfield offers £6 million in scholarships and bursaries to talented individuals. Millfield's reputation as the best sports school in the UK precedes it, however it's Top 100 students' in each year group attain academic results on a par with highly selective schools. The school also has outstanding facilities for music, drama and dance. It is home to 60 international athletes at any one time and a number of students compete professionally or at Olympic level. The community lives by the school values of Be Curious, Be Authentic, Be Disruptors, Be Kind and Be Brilliant.


- 30 different sports, 80 co-curricular options.


- The Millfield Diploma offers students to build a portfolio of experiences of entrepreneurship, resilience, service, inclusion, kindness and achieving success.
