The National Junior Honor Society is collecting gifts for Family & Children's Services Operation Sleighbells in Monmouth County. Operation Sleighbells is a FCS program that started in 1909, when a group of Long Branch community leaders provided gifts to children in need during the holidays. Today, Operation Sleighbells serves more than 1,500 children annually by enlisting hundreds of local businesses, churches, organizations, and families to donate to families who may be struggling during the holiday season.
