



Application and Selection Information Kindergarten 2024-2025

MARTHA AND JOSH MORRISS MATHEMATICS & ENGINEERING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submit the attached application between November 1, 2023 and January 12, 2024 either electronically or in person at the TISD Welcome Center.
- Applicants will be scheduled to take the math and reading readiness assessment in late February or early March 2024.
- After completing the assessment, families will be notified by mail of acceptance status no later than April 1, 2024.
- Parents of selected students must return the entrance agreement and registration documents by April 15, 2024.

SELECTION PROCESS

Kindergarten selection is determined using a scoring rubric. Points are awarded based on the student's performance on the required readiness assessments, sibling or parent employee status, and TISD district residency. Applicants with the highest composite score are selected for admittance.

Assessments will be given by appointment. The tentative dates for entrance testing are Saturday, February 24 and March 2, 2024. Students must complete the assessment on one of the designated dates to be eligible for selection. In January, staff will notify parents of their child's assigned appointment.

Additional rubric points will be given to applicants according to the following criteria:

- applicants with siblings enrolled at Morriss Elementary in kindergarten through grade 4 during the 2023-24 school year
- applicants with parents who are full-time employees at Morriss Elementary
- applicants who are TISD residents, as established by a matching address on the two requested documents

The district may offer a second testing opportunity if there are vacancies after the initial assessment. A student may only take the readiness assessment twice.

MATHEMATICS READINESS ASSESSMENT

THE CHILD CAN...

- Read numbers from 0 to at least 20
- Write numbers from 0 to at least 20
- Represent numbers from 0 to at least 20
- Solve word problems using objects and drawings to find sums up to 10 and differences within 10
- Compare sets of objects and numbers up to at least 20 in each set using comparative language
- Comparative language includes; more than, less than, greater than, fewer than, and equal to
- Identify attributes of two-dimensional shapes
- Draw conclusions from picture graphs
- Demonstrate basic number sense with numbers 0-20 to include but not limited to:
 - Counting forward and backward with and without objects
 - Counting sets of objects
 - Recognize instantly the quantity of a small group of objects in organized and random arrangements

READING READINESS ASSESSMENT

THE CHILD CAN...

- Identify uppercase and lowercase letters of the alphabet
- Identify and match the common sounds that letters represent
- Listen to a simple story and answer questions about what they heard
- Write their first name legibly
- Blend given word parts (Example: You make the sounds /m/ /a/ /p/. The child says map.)
- Read simple high frequency words
- Decode or read simple vc or cvc words (example: in, cat, pot)

The assessments are based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for Kindergarten as well as the Pre-K Guidelines. These can be found on the Texas Education Association website at www.tea.texas.gov by selecting the A-Z index and either TEKS by Grade or Pre-Kindergarten/Texas Pre-Kindergarten Guidelines.
