## Agenda

1. Review Fall District Benchmark and other progress monitoring data results (if available) and compare against "One Plan"/USIP goals – Fall STAR 360 Results and ELA Performance Matters CIA's
  - STAR 360 Reading for Fall 42.4% at/above benchmark for state
  - Will administer again in Dec and Spring (prior to CMAS)
  - Math district benchmark 49.3% at/above benchmark
  - Math 17.8 at/above State benchmark
  - Reading 47.5% at/above District benchmark
  
2. Instructional supports for RTI/MTSS Tier 2 and Tier 3 students including support to Gifted & Talented (GT) and English Language Learner (ELL) students Review/discuss school's focus on parent strategies for individual student support (i.e. parent and teacher as partners in student learning, with focus on student technology device use and support and closing COVID related gaps from 21-22)

Parent Strategy - Parent student support – math has the lowest growth rate, will take a while to get above 50, growth rate has been stagnant for quite a few years. Have a

resource that will determine the skill gap (Dream Box) that will incrementally help increase these gaps.

Would like to make it a requirement to have kids do 5 Dream Box lessons per week at home, will send out communication in Dec for Jan rollout. SAC to review communication Dec.

3. Review available progress monitoring data results and compare against "One Plan"/USIP goals

- SAC members took an 8<sup>th</sup> grade CIA for English to see how subjective these answers could be
- CMAS 52.7% Academic Growth performance indicator - we are at Improvement status (by a .3%) need to get up to Meets
- ELA 46 – 50 is a year's growth in a years' time, Math 41
- On Plan is to focus on Growth improvements MGP of 50 - 64
- Using CIA, STAR 360, CMAS
- Teachers try to move 10% in Star proficiency rates for each student (8 – 12 students get intervention to help)
