- One Plan Direction/Performance Challenges
  - MTSS schedule adjustments, the 20 minutes into the core class time and do intervention in the core class, this will be for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. 6<sup>th</sup> grade will continue the MTSS class rotation as they did well with it this year.
  - Class will have primary recency for the first part of the class before moving onto interventions.

  - Trauma response – teaching working on being regulated/grounded while out of the school in order to be better able to help deescalate using love and logic methods.

  - 5 Essential Results – focus groups with students conducted in order to understand what happened with the culture/climate results. Results of survey need reviewed by more people before being interpreted and shared.
