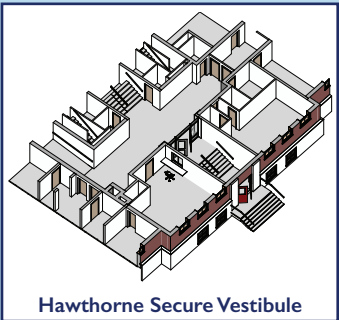


2023 INSTRUCTIONAL BOND

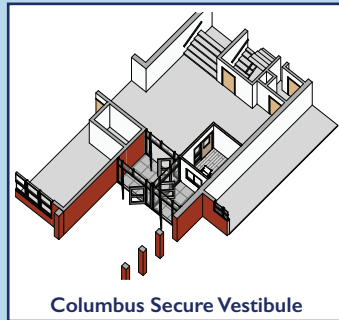

The proposed plan will enable us to systematically implement and complete important instructional enhancements across the District in the following areas:

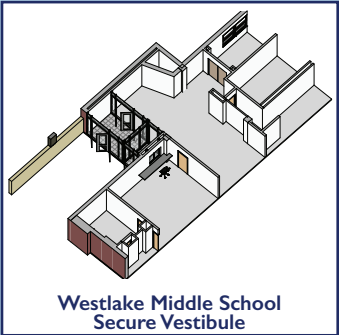
- ✓ Safety and Security

- ✓ Ventilation and Air Cooling of Large Instructional Spaces



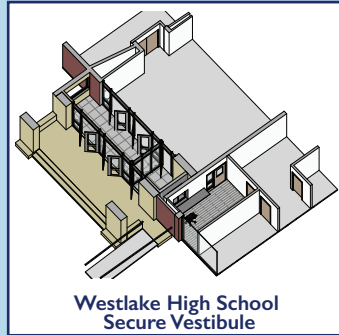
Hawthorne Secure Vestibule

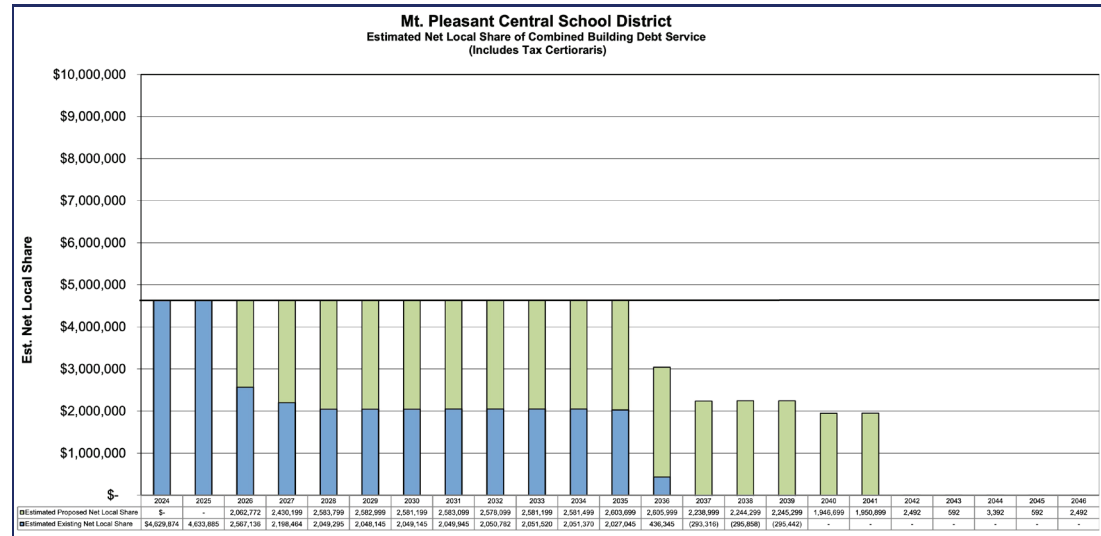

HAWTHORNE ELEMENTARY

- ☐ A secure entrance vestibule will be constructed, along with multiple enhancements in safety and security
- ☐ Complete reconfiguration of the current Kindergarten classrooms and a four classroom addition
- ☐ Reorganization of the school to cluster students by grade level and to centralize special area instruction and services
- ☐ A new center for performing arts, visual arts, STEM and a new Library and Media Center for school-wide events and community-use
- ☐ Bathrooms will receive long-overdue renovations

COLUMBUS ELEMENTARY

- ☐ A secure entrance vestibule will be constructed, along with multiple enhancements in safety and security
- ☐ Several classrooms will be renovated to support small group instruction
- ☐ Music spaces will be enlarged and transformed to accommodate group collaboration and instruction, including band, chorus, and a future orchestral program
- ☐ A new Makerspace/STEM Lab and three classrooms will be added

WESTLAKE CAMPUS

- ☐ Secure entrance vestibules as well as security cameras and devices at both WHS and WMS
- ☐ Renovations to all science labs
- ☐ WHS Cafeteria addition to make room for a new Makerspace/Innovation Lab
- ☐ John S. Whearty Theater gut renovation including lighting, rigging, and acoustical improvements
- ☐ WHS Studio Art Classroom renovation
- ☐ Library renovation to create a modern media center
- ☐ Ventilation upgrades as well as air conditioning to both gymnasiums
- ☐ WMS Locker Room renovation
- ☐ WHS cafeteria and kitchen renovations

Further provided that any person who has previously registered to vote in any annual School District meeting or election or special School District meeting or election and who has voted at an annual School District meeting or election or special School District meeting or election held during the past four years (2023, 2022, 2021, 2020) shall not be required to re-register.
