Activities will be aligned with STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) principles, preparing children for a future filled with exciting opportunities. The Construction experience classroom will be a space where imaginations can run wild!

Our goal at BHES is to provide play-based learning for our preschool students. Play-based learning provides opportunities for children to develop a sense of the world around them through inquiry, exploration, interaction and problem solving. Play-based learning is a context for learning where children can explore, experiment, discover and solve problems in imaginative and playful ways. A play-based learning environment is generally set up into sections providing opportunities for students to learn science, literacy, writing, reading, dramatic play, blocks and building, and social studies. Through play children can develop social and cognitive skills, mature emotionally, and gain the self-confidence required to engage in new experiences and environments. There is plenty of research around play-based learning and how it enhances children's academic and developmental learning outcomes. In fact, the current research has found play based and inquiry learning is vital if you want to set children up for success in both their future schooling and in their later adult life.
