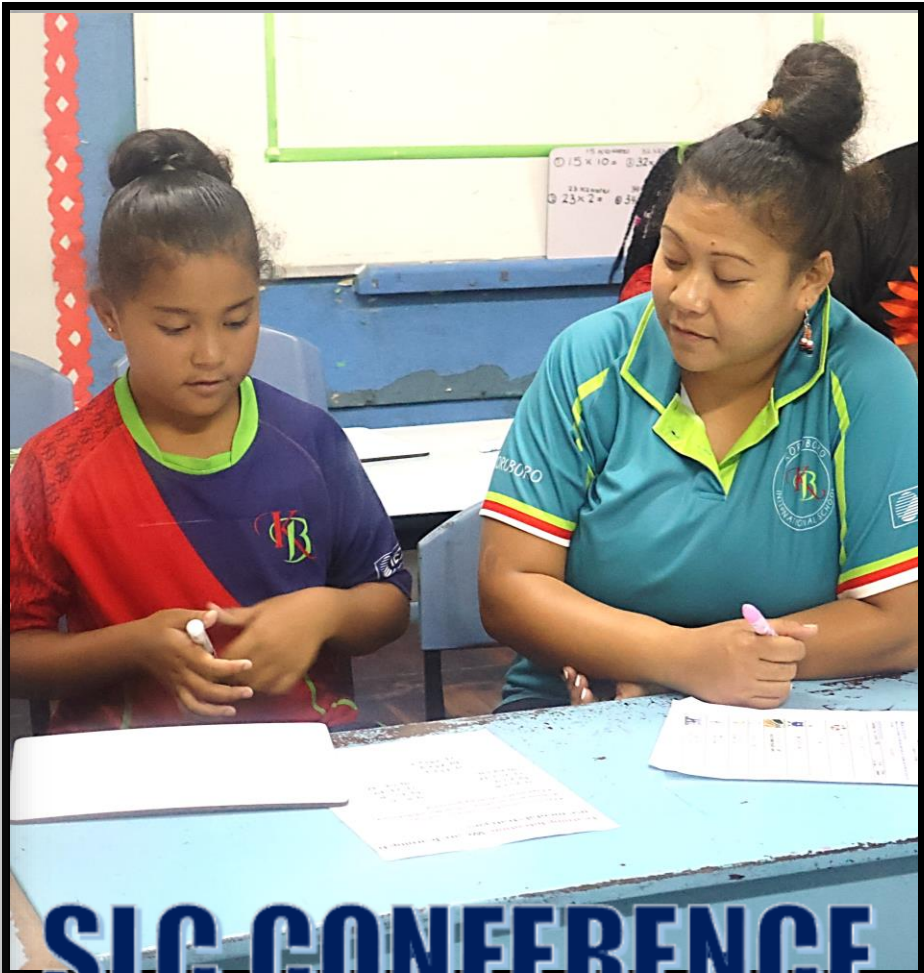

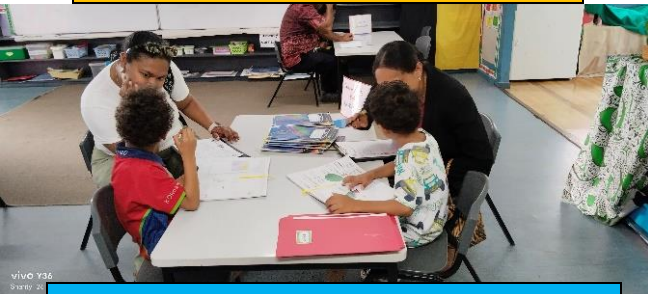

Reading Station: A student teaching his younger sibling to read using decoding strategies as parent observes and listen.



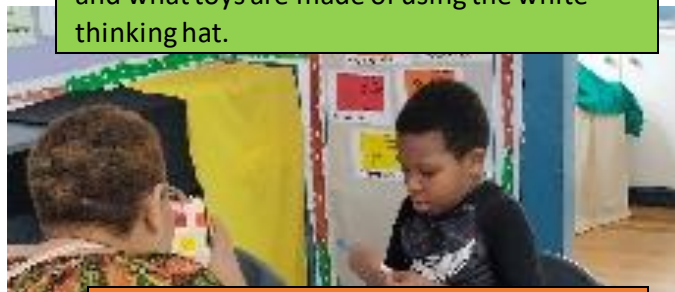
Work Book Station: Students excitedly shows their parents their best work in their work book.
